FRED

CASSIE

Because you get to bond together and it's really nice to know self defence.

DAVID

It was more fun when they were smaller, but, like, now they give me a run for my money and it's like, it's a lot less fun. Trust me.

FRED

KIRSTY

FRED

KIRSTY

FRED

KAIDEN

It's a long way away. I don't even know what GCSE's I'm gonna do and I'm supposed to be choosing them next week.

FRED

Kirsty, did you grow up in Wales?

KIRSTY

No. I'm from a little town called Bicester in Oxfordshire.

FRED

Ah, I know it. What brought you to Wales?

KIRSTY

David and his job.

FRED

So, David, did you grow up here?

DAVID

No, I also grew up just by Bicester in Oxfordshire. We are high school sweethearts. We've been together since we were 16. Oh, 17 years old.

FRED

DAVID

I came to Cardiff to go to film school, actually, a very famous film school, it was called Newport Film School. KAIDEN

I hope there are flying cars.

KIRSTY

I hope that the world keeps moving in the right direction and that everyone still is nice and kind to each other.
