<u>Museum of Stories: Bury Park</u> is a community audio walk of true local stories in a geolocated app. The route runs up and down Dunstable Road and is accessed through your smartphone.

Launched last year, Museum of Stories has been free in app stores for six months. This year, the team behind it will be running three timed walks along the route, aimed exclusively at Luton schools, colleges and youth groups.

The walk takes about an hour, with an optional free Q&A afterwards for another hour. Students can meet the team behind the project, ask questions, and gain an insight into both local history and the creative industries.

The walk content is suitable for all ages, though each walker will need their own smartphone so is likely to suit 13+.

Walks start and end outside <u>Alexandra Opticians</u>, <u>88 Dunstable Road</u>. Each walk can accommodate up to 30 students and we are encouraging schools to book in groups.

Walks must take place before the end of the summer term, we are currently canvassing teachers about the best dates and times of day.

Walks can be during timetabled classes, after school, or on a Saturday - whichever is easier to allow you to attend. We want as many local schools as possible to take advantage of this opportunity, so please let us know!
