#### **HOA DUES**

The Annual HOA Dues have been kept at a minimal fee for residents of Lake Florence Shores. The annual dues of \$100 is due by July 31, 2021. Dues are to be made payable to Lake Florence Shores and mailed to PO Box 560382, Montverde, FL 34756 or by Zelle to Ifshoa34756@gmail.com.

Due to the late mailing of invoices, there will not be a late fee assessed if paid by August 31, 2021.

Lake Florence Shores consists of 65 homes. There are currently 19 homes that are past due in paying the annual dues. To keep our annual dues at a nominal fee, it is imperative that dues are paid timely. If we are having to pursue past due balances, filing liens on properties, etc. this may increase the amount of dues each Homeowner will have to pay. Late fees will be assessed, as well as an administrative processing fee for accounts Past Due. If you are having a hardship, please contact the HOA Board to discuss payment arrangements.

### PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

While our HOA Rules and Regulations are fairly lenient, we do need to address concerns regarding the condition of properties in Lake Florence Shores. The upkeep of our properties, will continue to see the rising benefits in the real estate market. As a Homeowner, it is your responsibility to maintain your property. Areas of concern are:

- Lawn mowing
- Tree and shrub pruning
- Keeping lawn and garden areas alive, free of weeds, and attractive
- Fences and houses needing pressure washed; fences repaired
- Repainting of improvements
- Repair of exterior damages to improvements
- Prompt removal of all litter, trash, refuse, non-permitted vehicles and wastes

Any properties not complying with the care and maintenance noted above, will be contacted by the HOA Committee. If the owner does not comply within 30 days after contact, the HOA will provide the services and maintenance needed and the homeowner will be responsible to reimburse the HOA for such costs.



#### **STOP SIGNS AND SPEED LIMITS**



The STOP sign at Hillside Drive and Hillside Circle was changed from a Yield sign to a STOP sign a couple years back. Please adhere to this as the traffic flowing east on Hillside Circle do not have to yield or stop.

The speed limit in Lake Florence Shores is 25 MPH! Speeding through the neighborhood is dangerous. We have a lot of children and families walking their animals in the neighborhood. Let's keep everyone safe!
