We are honoured to be considered as your venue choice. The barn at Maple Meadows offers the rustic charm of original 1840's post and beam construction and is set on a family owned and operated organic farm in Port Colborne.

Renovated in 2018 the barn accommodates up to 200 guests and offers two ideal rooms for the whole wedding party to get ready for the day, a loft mezzanine, and a rustic tack room. The barn features indoor washrooms, a mobile bar, and a prep room for your caterer.

Say your vows surrounded by family and friends under the maple trees in a beautiful 2-acre lawn space. After the ceremony enjoy the space for cocktails, photos, or games. Gorgeous gardens border this area with a view over the pasture that has a few horses and a little donkey named Gus who is always happy to greet your guests. The barn features an outdoor courtyard or an indoor ceremony area insuring a beautiful ceremony space regardless of the weather.



Here at Maple Meadows the possibilities are endless.

- Catering is open for your choice. We have a list of recommended Vendors to help you get started on planning your day. If using a caterer that is not on our recommended Vendor we ask to have a meeting with them prior to booking to ensure their catering needs are met with our facility.
- You may bring in your own alcohol with a Special Occasion Permit (approx. 45.00 from LCBO online). We have all needed information ready for you for easy online application.
- Maple Meadows has flower cutting gardens for your DIY bouquets
(up to 3 pails of fresh in-season flowers are included in rental)
If you need extra flowers an order can be placed for you with UFD at wholesale prices ie: eucalyptus, roses ,baby's breath ect.
- Music is provided by 905 DJCO Company, with a new in house sound system. Their base package pricing starts at \$1300, with options for upgrades with lighting and more services.
- Music turn-off is 11 pm, with guests being asked to be off the property by 12 midnight.
- The wedding party can remain until 1 am, if noise is kept to a minimum.

- Friday 8am -12am
- Teardown by Maple Meadows. Decor items can be picked up Saturday morning before 10am, or Sunday after 2pm. Couple to provide labeled storage bins for personal decor items.

SATURDAY WEDDINGS

- Thursday access for 1 hour for rehearsal
- Saturday 8am to 12am
- Sunday DIY Teardown 8am to 1pm
- Setup by Maple Meadows & day of coordinator
- Meeting with Coordinator 2 weeks prior to event for setup plan

Frequently Asked Questions

Where are you located?

We are 736 Weaver Rd, Port Colborne. Ontario

Can I come for a tour?

Yes, please send us an email to set up at time.

How many guest can I have?

Our Barn can comfortably accommodate 200 guests. We provide tables and chairs (see list below).

Are you handicap accessible ?

We want to make sure all your guests can experience your special day. The venue is completely accessible except for the loft.

Can I bring in my own alcohol?

Yes. A special occasions permit is needed. We have all the information ready for you for easy application. Smart serve bartenders are a must.

Can I bring my pets?

Yes! We would love to have them join the celebration, however please keep them on leash.

Is there heat or air conditioning?

Large heaters are available for use in May & October. Couples are responsible for cost of fuel if used. Large doors will remain closed when heaters are in use.

Air conditioning is available for the den area if needed. Port Colborne quite often has a nice breeze coming off the lake to keep it comfortable during the summer heat.

Can I bring in my own DJ? Or Band?

Unfortunately no, We have worked with many different DJ companies, and found the best fit for our venue is 905 DJCO. They have several DJ's to choose from.


You are welcome to bring in your own live music for both ceremony and reception. 905 DJCO fee is not waived.

Is smoking allowed on premises?

Yes, but only in designated areas.

Can I have Fireworks or Sparklers?

Fireworks are allowed on statutory holidays and must be done by a professional company. Sparkers are allowed in grass area and must have a bucket of water for disposal.
