Colleagues,

Tow that we will (mostly) no longer be virtual, we're offering updated Units of Study Virtual Teaching Resources to meet a somewhat different set of needs in the coming school year. As I think you know, my colleagues and I have always known there are advantages and disadvantages to filming ourselves teaching and providing you with those videos. The kids so want YOU—and we all want for school to involve that intimate gathering on the rug. That is important in a reading workshop and, we think, all-important in the writing workshop.

So for the 2021–22 school year, we will release the K-2 reading and phonics Virtual Teaching Resources and encourage you to use them in any way that is helpful. We do this because we believe that no kids have taken a harder hit during the pandemic than K-2 kids, and we know primary teachers will have their hands full offering the multilevel support that those kids will need. We can imagine that teachers' entire focus may need to be on small group work. If the filmed sessions make that possible, we are all for it.

We are also releasing the upper-grade reading Virtual Teaching Resources. However, as you consider how you will use these resources, please keep in mind that the virtual lessons are built around short stories and articles, not the read-aloud of whole books, and we think reading the books aloud will be all-important. So we recommend you use the Virtual Teaching Resources for any classes that remain virtual, but we also want you to use them as PD for all intermediate teachers—but please be sure to pair the support in the videos with the corresponding print units to bring whole books from those print units into your instruction.

In addition to grade-level subscriptions for reading and phonics, we'll also release the Up the Ladder units in fiction and nonfiction—and also in writing. These units are especially good for intermediate teachers who are new to our work.

We'll release a few additional units from the 2021-22 TCRWP Suggested Sequence for which there aren't printed Units of Study books available (e.g., Detail and Synthesis in grade 4). We hope you watch them at home and then teach those lessons yourselves.

I also need to tell you that we're not releasing the writing Units of Study Virtual

Teaching Resources to all as we did last year. This is because when the new school year starts and we can finally be together with our children again, we think it is really important for you to go back to teaching writing in a heart-to-heart way, just you and the kids. We hope that most of the slides that were made this year are set aside and that you teach writing as personally as possible.

And one last thing—because we are aware that the start of the year will be especially challenging for everyone and you may want to begin the year with a unit which catches kids up on foundational skills from the previous year, we will release our new summer school curriculum as a beginning of the year, Ramp-Up unit in case some of you will find that helpful.

I wish you a very happy reunion with your students and colleagues and a joyful year ahead.



Reading & Writing Comics: Intensive Phonemic Awareness and Phonics Instruction for Selected Students, Rising Grades 4–6

◆ 25 PHONICS SESSIONS, 18 PHONEMIC AWARENESS SESSIONS, AND 8 COMIC ARTIST CAMEO VIDEOS

In this engaging unit, students will author comic books that can become reading material for each other. That is, they have an important reason to use their imaginations, their art skills, their story ideas, and their phonological awareness and phonics skills to create—and spell—readable texts.

Although the unit was created with student engagement at its heart, it is also designed to teach a sequenced, researchbased, assessment-based curriculum to provide kids with the explicit instruction, opportunities for repeated practice. accessible texts, feedback, and supportive community they need to get traction as readers and writers, making demonstrable, important progress.

Students are launched into this work by learning they will each be creating a series of comics to share with other students. They will discover that as their skills as writers and comic book artists grow, the texts they can read and write will also grow more sophisticated. In Bend I, students will begin with the most accessible and foundational phonemic awareness and phonics concepts, but that learning will be couched in a key characteristic of comic fun: onomatopoeia. Teachers will teach students to hear, write, and read the sounds that will show up in the books they read and write.

In Bend II, students progress into more complex understandings, including manipulation of phonemes and seeing the connections between phonics and the high-frequency words they most use in their comic reading and writing. Using comic features such as speech bubbles, students will explore purposeful ways to isolate words and then return them to meaning and context. In Bend III, as students grow in their confidence as readers and writers of comics, they are encouraged to take risks in longer form comics as well as more illustrated texts. They look across their collection of created comics and consider the best ways to share these with other young readers.

Teaching very young children to read when school has been virtual, interrupted, or socially distant hasn't been easy. This series of videos will help teachers provide children with some of the companionship and coaching that they have been missing, while also modeling warm, supportive, fun ways that parents and teachers can read side-by-side with children.

Reading Partners: Guiding Readers Up Levels (Three modules: KLMN, OPQR, STUV and corresponding Library Shelves)

While these modules can be used with any of the intermediate fiction units, we recommend that you also pair them with the Reading Series Fiction unit as part of your backto-school Ramp-Up plan. This pairing will allow readers to work in close alliance with TCRWP reading coaches during work time. Videos feature TCRWP coaches who engage individual readers or reading partners, give invitations and feedback to support students in doing the work that each specific series (and band of text complexity) requires, and hold students accountable for the reading work they are doing.

You may choose to pair students up, so they can read these series and engage with these tutorials in partnerships, so they have more reasons to jot and share their jottings, and meaningful opportunities to talk to each other about their books and their reading work. But you can also set students up independently.




Up the Ladder Reading Virtual Teaching Resources, Grades 4-6

Up the Ladder Writing Virtual Teaching Resources, Grades 4-6

The Up the Ladder Writing units are designed for students in grades 3–6 who might not have had experiences in writing workshop classrooms. Although designed to be precursors to the grade-level writing Units of Study, these units can be helpful in a variety of settings.
