

## SUGGESTED 4-6 WEEK PLAN



## Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI)

## **Suggestions:**

- If students have been receiving LLI during the previous school year, continue with the lesson sequence from where they left off.
- If students have not been receiving LLI during the previous school year, assess the students (using Benchmark Assessment System, Third edition) to determine instructional reading level. Form groups of students who are reading at approximately the same instructional level.
  Begin LLI lessons at the group's instructional reading level.
- Students could reread *LLI* books independently outside of the *LLI* lesson (during independent reading).

- Students read books of their choosing every day for independent reading.
- Depending on grade-level and time available each day, both an Odd and Even lesson could be completed in one day.
- Focus on extra writing time and opportunities: shared writing, interactive writing, and/or independent writing.
- Focus on shared reading with enlarged texts and shared writing.
- Use Gamemaker to create activities and games for students to practice concepts learned.
