

# VILLAGE OF SEBEWAING

Your pick up day is THURSDAY.

You **MUST** have ALL materials out by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.

## COLLECTION INFORMATION

**TRASH, RECYCLING & COMPOST (April-November)** . (see calendar). If a holiday falls on or before your scheduled day, pickup will be one (1) day later than normal. If a holiday falls on a weekend, your scheduled pick up day will NOT change. **OBSERVED HOLIDAYS ARE:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

**ALL TRASH MUST BE BAGGED IN TRASH BAGS AND SET AT THE CURB BY 6:00 a.m.** on the scheduled day of pick up. Trash must be **BAGGED IN TRASH BAGS** and may be placed in containers that should not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds each. For those with special pick up needs, contact your Village Office at (989) 883-2150. **MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRINGS MUST** be in plastic bag or wrapped and secured in plastic.

**UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:** Tires, concrete, fencing, any contractor generated materials, liquids (paints, pesticides, etc), car parts, appliances containing Freon, fluorescent bulbs and car batteries.

## COMPOST/YARD WASTE

Emterra Environmental USA will provide compost pick up weekly April thru November. Please have compost placed curbside by 6am on Day of Service. Service will run April 2, 2026 through November 27, 2026.

Place yard waste in brown yard waste bags or in 30-gallon containers clearly marked "X" facing the street. Branches are to be no more than two (2) inches in diameter, no longer than four (4) feet in length, and must be bundled. Bundles and containers must weigh less than 50 pounds. **No tree stumps or trunks, dirt or mulch are accepted. No compost will be accepted in plastic bags.**

## RECYCLING

- **YOU DO NOT NEED TO SORT RECYCLABLE ITEMS!**

- **NO PLASTIC BAGS OR STYROFOAM ACCEPTED!**

<b>Newspaper</b>	Place newspapers, phone books, magazines & glossy newspaper inserts in brown paper bags or bundle and tie with string.
<b>Cardboard</b>	Clean corrugated cardboard must be bundled and tied in two (2) foot squares, not exceeding a thickness of one (1) foot.
<b>Plastic #1-7</b>	Plastics should be rinsed clean with the cap removed. No motor oil, anti-freeze or cooking oil containers please.
<b>Cans</b>	Clean tin and aluminum cans. These items may be flattened to conserve space in your container.
<b>Glass</b>	Clear, empty glass only. The glass should be rinsed out.
