For previous animals you owned, provide photos and Embark DNA result to evidence content. If experience cannot be adequately proven with photos and DNA, then we cannot consider the stated experience as adequate. For those who don't have satisfactory experience but are willing to volunteer here or at another facility, we will require between 6 months to 1 year experience to be adequately trained.
