

#### Cannot Marry in the Catholic Church Due to A Prior Marriage?

Pope Francis streamlined the process to petition for a declaration of nullity to make the process shorter. He also eliminated the mandatory fee. If a person is able to prove in this process that their prior martial bond was invalid for some reason, that he or she can marry in the Catholic Church or validate a current civil marriage. # **Sunday Connection**

Luke 9:28-36

Jesus is transfigured on the mountain in the presence of Peter, James, and

John.

Elijah and Moses are both significant figures in the history of Israel. Moses led the Israelites from slavery in Egypt and received from Yahweh the Ten Commandments. Appearing with Jesus at his Transfiguration, Moses represents the Law, which guides the lives of the Jewish people. Elijah is remembered as one of the most important prophets of Israel who helped the Israelites stay faithful to Yahweh. Some believe that Elijah's return would signal the coming of the Messiah for the Jewish people. This belief is evidenced in the question posed by Jesus' disciples after they have witnessed the Transfiguration. The appearance of these two important figures from Israel's history indicates Jesus' continuity with the Law and the prophets. They also reveal that Jesus is the fulfillment of all that was promised to the people of Israel.

In his Transfiguration, we see an anticipation of the glory of Jesus' Resurrection. The disciples' are confused as they wondered what Jesus meant by "rising from the dead." Until they also witness his passion and death, the disciples cannot possibly understand Jesus' Transfiguration.

We see in this event an anticipation of Jesus' Resurrection, a foreshadowing of Christ's glory in heaven, and the promise of our own resurrection.

### Marriage Preparation Requirements

**1st meeting**: The couple needs to meet and do an interview. Couple will meet together and separately with pastor or designated person.

You will be provided with Engagement Encounter registration information. Couples must procure from their church of baptism a new baptismal certificate with notations. Circumstances regarding couples' status for marriage will be discussed and proper steps initiated hence forth.

**<u>IMPORTANT</u>**: The date for the wedding is to be set after the Engagement Encounter class requirement is fulfilled.

 $2^{nd}$  meeting: You get acquainted with the presider who will officiate. Completion of the following to take place: Premarital Inventory, discussions on marriage, quality of the relationship, spiritual and religious practices, and family.

**Meetings to follow** will depend on how much more discussion is needed for the couple and being sure all forms have been complete.

**Engagement Encounter Certificate** is a requirement and must be presented after completing the class.

Marriage license acquired before the wedding date.

#### A Brute-Force Strategy for Cataloging Members of Open Clusters

Open stellar clusters are young (generally one Gyr and younger) and coeval (formed in single events from a distinct molecular cloud) groups of stars that are gravitationally bound. Thus, they are among the best candidates for providing precise information on both the ages and chemical compositions at various spatial positions in the Milky Way disk. In addition, they play an integral part in the understanding of stellar evolution and assist us in ascertaining the history, structure, dynamics, and chemical evolution of the Milky Way. Recent work by Karla Peña Ramírez (U. of Antofagasta) led to the development of new analysis tools that allow for an increase up to 50% of known stellar members in open clusters located in the bulge and in the disk. This has a significant impact on the derived fundamental parameters, such as extinction and total mass. Motivated by this work, we studied a sample of two dozen open clusters using photometric and astrometric data from the Gaia Data Release 3 (DR3), complemented by near-infrared data from the Vista Variables in the Via Lactea Survey (VVV) and the Two-Micron All-Sky Survey (2MASS). The technique used was based on Gaussian mixture models and unsupervised machine-learning methods, which allowed us to identify the members of each cluster. We first performed a reanalysis of the membership in a previous study made by Peña Ramírez et al., in order to reproduce results and confirm adequate performance of the computer code used in our study. Alterations were then made to portions of code to broaden the extent of their collective cluster-cataloging ability. This approach to cluster-member selection allows for a large-scale evaluation of the Galactic plane,

serving as a valuable tool for assessing cluster populations and testing of stellar evolutionary models.


