# LIVING THE WORD

## A Reflection on Sunday's Gospel

Luke 18:1-18

Today's short and striking parable is found only in Luke and because it is ambiguous and provocative it can have various interpretations. The parable tells us that it is necessary to continue praying without growing weary and giving up. It tells us not to be discouraged by the injustice of this world. It tells us if we persist then no matter what our struggles may be they are not in vain. It tells us not to lose heart for prayer is a source of strength. Jesus assures us that God always hears our prayer.

Like Moses in the first reading and the widow in the parable, what must drive us forward in times of uncertainty and difficulty are consistency and perseverance. We will never grow weary in our prayer, nor falter in our faith, if in our personal prayer we include the perfect prayer: "Thy will be done."

Take a few moments of silent prayer and reflect how persistent are you in your daily prayers.

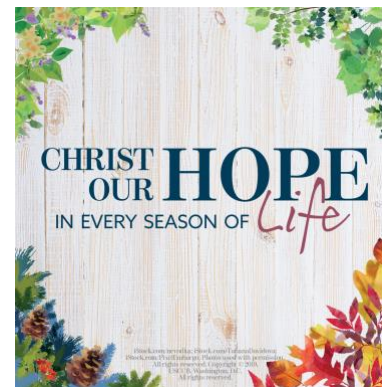
