1. Purchase Price

2. Health Guarantee & Veterinary Requirement

*The Buyer **must** have the kitten examined by a licensed veterinarian within **48 hours** of delivery or pickup. Failure to complete this vet check within the specified timeframe will void any health guarantees.

3. Trupanion Insurance Activation

The Buyer agrees to activate Trupanion Pet Insurance (using the provided breeder code or activation link) within 24 hours of receiving the kitten. This is a free 30-day coverage plan and must be activated for the health guarantee and replacement policy to remain valid.

4. Replacement Policy

If the kitten is found by a licensed veterinarian to have a life-threatening congenital or hereditary condition within the first 12 months, and Trupanion was activated and the initial vet check completed within 48 hours, the Seller will offer a replacement kitten-Documentation from the veterinarian is required.

- Replacement is subject to availability and may require wait time for a future litter.

- **No** cash refunds will be provided.

Seller cannot guarantee the lifetime health of this animal, nor that it will not contact a viral or bacterial illness sometime in the future.

- Health problems related to the environmental conditions including, but not limited to parasites, change in diet, allergies and litter training are not covered in the health guarantee.
- Problems stemming from failure to provide sanitary conditions including, but not limited to food, water, and waste disposal (litter box) are not covered in the health guarantee.
- Declawing is NOT recommended. Any problems occurring from this action will NOT be covered in the health guarantee.
- The seller assumes no responsibility for this feline after leaving the premises for medical expenses or mortality. The seller will not be responsible for injury to the feline after leaving the premises.

5. Buyer Responsibilities

The Buyer agrees to:

- Provide appropriate food, shelter, love, and regular veterinary care.
 - Keep the kitten indoors only.
 - Never sell, rehome, or surrender the kitten without notifying the Seller.
 - Have the kitten spayed/neutered by ___/___/___ unless breeding rights are granted.
 - Not use the kitten for breeding unless explicitly agreed in **Section 6**
- Seller cannot guarantee the lifetime health of this animal, nor that it will not contact a viral or bacterial illness sometime in the future.
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- The seller will not be responsible for injury to the feline after leaving the premises
