- Based on: Sensitivity and specificity of a shortened elimination diet protocol for the diagnosis of food-induced atopic dermatitis (FIAD) Fischer N et al (2021) https://doi.org/10.1111/vde.12940
- Alternative to classic 6-8 week protocol
- Control any infections and eliminate parasitic diseases
- 66% sensitivity; 2/3 of cases identified after 2 weeks of prednisolone. 3 weeks no different outcome
- 95% sensitivity after further week of prednisolone in relapsing cases
- Apoquel sensitivity, same protocol, only 63%
