We are excited to share that we will be going on a field trip to learn more about the Titanic! There is a special Titanic section currently at Cosi in Columbus.

On Wednesday, April 3 all 3rd through 6th graders and their teachers will be traveling by bus to Cosi. We need to leave school by 8:00, so **all students need to arrive at school between 7:30 and 7:45**. We will travel to Columbus, explore parts of Cosi, eat our packed lunches there, and then spend 1 ½ hours in the Titanic display there. Then we will load the bus and travel back to Van Wert. We will **NOT** be back in time for students to ride any buses home. **Please plan to pick up your child after 3:30.** Latchkey will be available for everyone through 5:30.

Mrs. Koenig will provide a packed lunch for each child: sub sandwich OR peanut butter sandwich, carrots, applesauce, cookie, and milk. IF your child has a dietary restriction that requires packing his/her own lunch, please notify the teacher.
