EdChoice Expansion Scholarship

If you are a parent planning on applying for the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship for next year, **PLEASE RETURN THAT INFORMATION TO THE SCHOOL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.** The only window to apply for this scholarship will be closing soon. If you have any questions, please call the School Office and we will be happy to assist you. The Ohio Department of Education **has increased the amount for eligibility** for this scholarship to 250% above poverty level. For example: a Family of 4 whose household income is \$66,250 or less are now eligible. This scholarship is first come - first served and once the scholarship funds have been allocated, no more applications will be accepted for the upcoming school year. Because of the increase in eligibility funds are expected to max out.

Kindergarten Screening

A FREE Kindergarten developmental readiness screening for all children will be held at St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic School. Any child who will be 5 years of age by September 30th, 2021 and lives in Van Wert County or the surrounding area, is invited to attend. Screening appointments can be set up for Monday, March 1st, Tuesday, March 2nd, Monday, March 8th, or Tuesday, March 9th screenings will run from 3:30pm – 5:30pm.
