Tom Larson of Lake Champlain Maritime Museum taught me how to create my first kitchen knife from scratch. It's actually a piece of art that I can use.

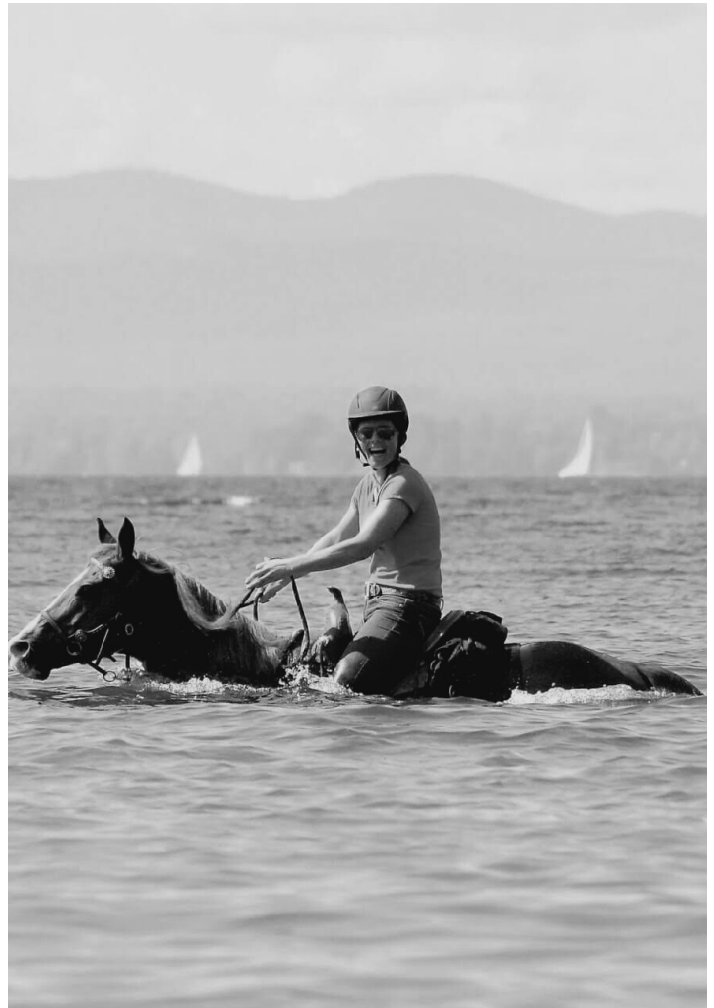
EQUINE AFFAIRE
