

ELEMENTS OF THE PROGRAM:

- An MOU is created between the school district and Education Alive
- Teacher(s) is/are recruited/appointed within the school to lead the program (EA helps guide this process.)
- Teacher(s) is/are trained by Education Alive staff to implement the Navigator curriculum
- Education Alive provides classroom materials needed to run the program which includes, supply box, journals, resource books, classroom assignments, reflection tickets, and easy access for teachers to feedback.
- Student Mentors are specifically recruited. (EA helps guide this process.)
- Student Mentors are trained in a joint effort between Education Alive staff and teachers.
- A parent and community meeting is held at the school and led by Education Alive staff in collaboration with school personnel to help all stakeholders understand the program and begin forming alliances with community partners.
- Student Mentors are provided a mini booster training to ensure they are ready to invest in underclassmen.
- Education Alive staff provides needed research to school administrators based on student responses.
