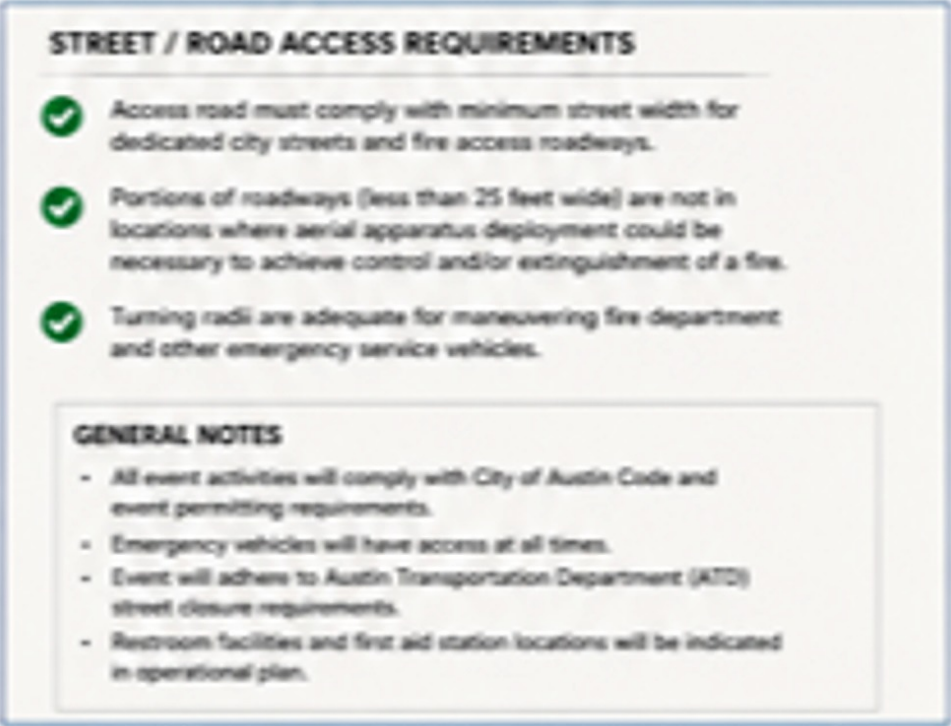
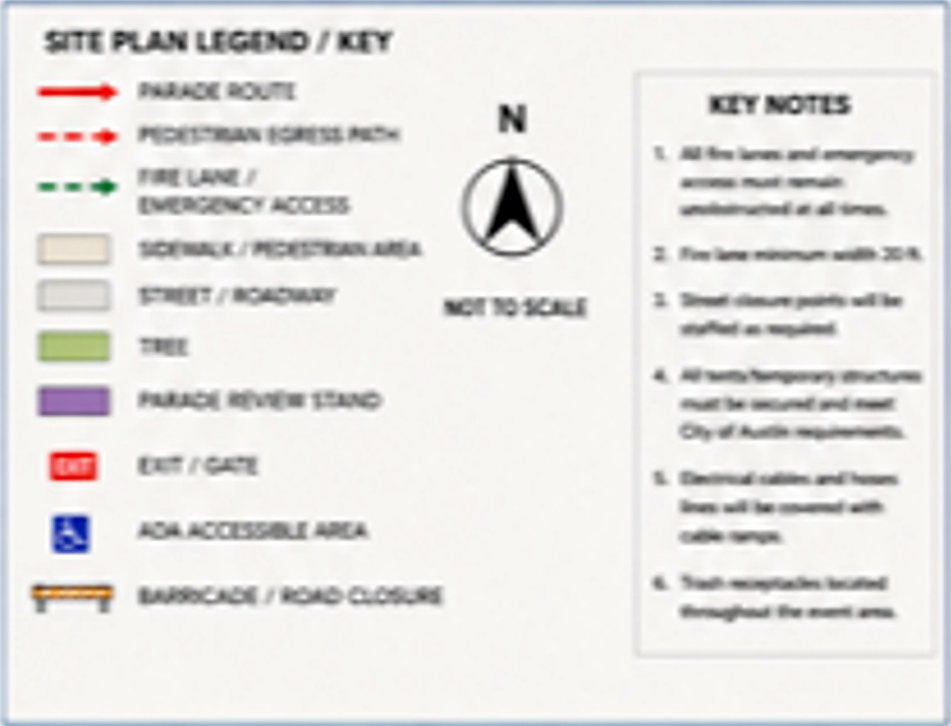
START	Congress Avenue Bridge / 1st Street area (Riverside & Congress)
ROUTE	North on Congress Avenue toward the Texas State Capitol
REVIEW STAND	Stephen F. Austin Hotel - near 7th Street & Congress Avenue
END	11th Street at the Texas State Capitol
DISTANCE	Approximately 0.65 miles

- Red - parade route / end
- Blue - reviewing stand / key location

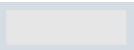

KEY NOTES

1. All fire lanes and emergency access must remain unobstructed at all times.
2. Fire lane minimum width: 20 ft.
3. Street-closure points will be staffed as required.
4. Temporary structures must be secured and meet City of Austin requirements.
5. Electrical cables and hose lines should be secured with cable ramps.
6. Trash receptacles are located throughout the event area.

ROAD ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

-  Access roads must comply with minimum street-width requirements for dedicated city streets and fire-access roadways.
-  Roadway portions less than 25 feet wide should not be located where aerial-apparatus deployment could be necessary to control or extinguish a fire.
-  Turning radii must be adequate for maneuvering fire-department and other emergency-service vehicles.

GENERAL NOTES

- All event activities will comply with City of Austin Code and event-permitting requirements.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
- The event will adhere to Austin Transportation Department (ATD) street-closure requirements.
- Restroom facilities and first-aid station locations will be identified in the operational plan.
