





An annual festival commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ, observed as a **religious and cultural celebration** among billions of people around the world.




The viewing of the Nativity play is one of the oldest Christmas

traditions, with the first reenactment of the Nativity of Jesus taking place in A.D. 1223.

The first recorded date of Christmas being celebrated **on Dec. 25 was in 336**, during the time of the Roman Emperor Constantine. It is now a public holiday in many parts of the world.

A number of figures are associated with Christmas and the seasonal giving of gifts. Among these are **Father Christmas**, also known as Santa Claus.







The traditional greeting reads 'wishing you a Merry

Christmas and a Happy New Year,' much like that of the first commercial Christmas card, produced by Sir Henry Cole in London in 1843.




coupons and purchased mostly Bogo items to get
