The March for Life St. Augustine, an annual event that unites pro-life advocates from Florida and Georgia, has been a powerful witness to the sanctity of human life since its inception in January 2007. However, there have been recent changes: Final March in St. Augustine (2023): The 17th annual March for Life took place in St. Augustine on January 13-14, 2023. The theme for this final St. Augustine march was "We choose to love them both!"-a poignant reminder of our commitment to both mothers and unborn children. This marked the last opportunity for participants to march locally in St. Augustine. Transition to Tallahassee (2024):Starting in 2024, all March for Life events will be conducted in state capitols, including Tallahassee, to encourage state legislators to pass life-saving protections for the unborn. The decision to move the events to Tallahassee came after the U.S. Supreme Court's overturning of Roe v. Wade in June.. III

The March for Life in Washington, D.C. is scheduled on Friday, January 19, 2024. The theme for the March for Life is "Pro-Life: With Every Woman, For Every Child.
