

FROM THE GRAND KNIGHT...





In his 1928 autobiography, Marching Along, Sousa wrote that he composed the march on Christmas Day, 1896. He was on board an ocean liner on his way home from a vacation with his wife in Europe and had just learned of the recent death of David Blakely, the manager of the Sousa Band. He composed the march in his head and committed the notes to paper on arrival in the United States.

It was first performed at Willow Grove Park, just outside Philadelphia, on May 14, 1897, and was immediately greeted with enthusiasm.

Following an Act of Congress in 1987, it was officially adopted as the national march of the United States of America and played on July 4th, Independence Day.

Knights are called to serve others. Our first principle is Charity – at home with our families and in our communities. When Knights of Columbus members come together they accomplish great things.



OUR LADY OF HOPE

By Sr. Knight Colm Murphy Our Lady of Hope is located on SR16, across from Our Lady of Good Council church. It is sometimes referred to as Cenacle or "the farm". It is a place where "young people who were lost, deceived and disappointed can seek the true meaning of life in the false light of the world. It provides a source of hope and resurrection for people lost in the world of darkness, who are sad, marginalized, desperate, drugged. There are cur-

What the Knights do for Our Lady of Hope:

The community relies on Gods providence through the generosity of the community. Our parish often delivers leftover food items from CRHP weekends, parish dinners, etc. Starting this past April, we have delivered store bought food items, such as fresh fruit, meats, cheeses, breads, and other everyday food items. We have a monthly budget of \$70 to provide these items and deliver them the 3rd Saturday of the month – on the same day as the 60 bagged lunches we prepare for St Francis House in St Augustine.
