In the center of the picture on the right is Tara Provini, Administrative Manager, Catholic Charities Bureau, St. Augustine Regional Office.



**Donations:** The Total 2021-2022 F/YRs Donation to Christ Cupboard Food Pantry was **\$7297** that **totalled 2092 pounds** (all detailed receipts, charity year end letter and monthly reports attached)

BOGO Donations are made by collecting cash and coupon donations at each monthly meeting. The cash is then used to buy groceries at the local "Buy One Get One" sale with the use of both matched up manufactures and store coupons to use at Publix, CVS, Winn Dixie and Walmart supermarkets. Minimally we shoot for doubling the value of the donations. We have more than tripled our money on most items when a good coupon/sale opportunity arises. The hours for the weekly hunting / cutting coupons, reports, shopping and delivery were 540 this year. Unused coupons are re-donated to the military.

The final grocery purchases are donated monthly to our usual **local St Johns County** charitable organizations. Christ's Cupboard Food Pantry/ Bank, St. Johns share with St. Francis House Homeless Shelter and Armstrong Migrant community center all local county food banks.

Our Council members collect weekly coupon inserts. All these are used as a base with weekly ads in our BOGO buys. Plus, all the unused coupons are donated to a local group that mails these to the Military overseas which can continue using expired coupons. This works out to added savings down the line.
