

## **Indivisible Tri-Cities TN, Inc. Privacy Notice**

At Indivisible Tri-Cities TN, Inc. ("we," or "us"), we value the privacy of individuals who use our websites and related services (collectively, our "Services"). This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, and share the personal information of users of our Services ("users," "you," or "your"). By using our Services, you agree to the collection, use, disclosure, and processing of your information as described by this Privacy Notice.

Personal information is information that identifies or could be used to identify a specific person. Personal information does not include deidentified information (anonymized or pseudonymized) or aggregated information derived from personal information.

We may collect a variety of personal information and other information about you or your devices from various sources, as described below.

### **Information You Provide to Us**

**Communications.** If you enter your contact information or any additional information about yourself on the Contact Us or similar page on this site, we will retain that information. If you contact us through our email address or other means we may retain any communication to us or information you provide to us.

**Events.** If you register for an event that we host or promote, whether to attend in-person or online, we may retain any contact information or identifying information that you provide, along with the event that you registered for. If you follow a registration link provided on our site to a third-party registration and scheduling site any information you provide to that link will be governed by the Privacy Policy of that third-party site.

A persistent cookie remains

We may use the information we collect:

- To promote Indivisible TriCities TN INC, our activities, our social and political messaging, or offer you links to our promotional merchandise.
- To detect and prevent fraud, and respond to trust and safety issues that may arise;
- In connection with generative AI applications;

**Our officers and affiliate volunteer organizers.** We are a volunteer organization. **If you ask to be included on our mailing list :** your contact information will be handled by volunteers who maintain our mailing list. **If you volunteer** for an activity, your contact information will be shared with the volunteers organizing that particular activity, and perhaps with other volunteers who are expected to cooperate and communicate with each other to further the activity. **If you make a donation** to our organization, your information will be seen and processed by the volunteers who manage our accounts, donation records, and acknowledgements. **If you initiate any communication** with Indivisible TriCities TN INC, our officers, or our volunteer affiliates, your contact information and the entire communication may be shared with particular volunteers assigned to respond to or process your communication.

Any such disclosure may become a public record, and may be posted on the web sites of the FEC or TREF.

**Other Users.** Any information you provide to us through the Contact Us or similar page on this site will not be visible to other users on this web site.
