Looking over the Heavy Haul industry and vehicle transport. The market is not friendly with the working class in buying new vehicles (American Vehicles) The American Vehicles

GM (Chevy, Only sell Corvette and this car is priced at \$100K or better. How many vehicles are going to be sold in a environment that makes \$100k Combined Income. The monthly income will be \$8,333.33 Monthly Gross

Total Hours of 172 Hours and a hourly rate of \$48.45 hourly gross. A new Corvette Build is not designed for the working man unless a house is refinance to obtain the money. In todays market it is not wise to borrow from 104K to buy a new car.

So that being said delivery cars is best to have a fleet account with the government.

It might be wise to build the corvette by hand to get a demand for the car instead of a supply of cars in the Eastern North Carolina market.

To ship cars in bulk i need American to meet the Honda, Toyota, Nissan and Mazda market to ship American Cars.

In Shipping GM and GMC Trucks. It would be better to ship them on a step deck contract. Business owners and Retire outdoors enthuses.

In American Vehicles over 60% of the new Vehicles are still in the lot where the living wages are \$20.00+ per hour. On a 10 Car Transporter only 4 vehicles are sold out of 10 in these markets. It is a used car market. However some used cars are more expensive than new. Then we have Repo Vehicles being sold in auctions and resold again. You have wreck vehicles being ship to junk yards for parts.

I need to sit down with Operations Managers and see what they offer to ship cars. American Automakers will not make a vehicle that is not selling. So once again it is best to get a distrubtion deal with the government where every year they buy certain amount of vehicles.

We are getting established in this market where business is dropping out of the market because of overhead expenses. So i need to be perfect to get in the door.

Lets stick with Heavy Haul and General Freight. My construction experience will boost me up in the market.

We need to be perfect in hauling cars as i first choice.

Is it beneficial to live off the grid in a RV or Tow Behind Motor home in today's market? You lose money on a RV if you try to sell it It is better to trade it in. You can't borrow money off the RV like a house. You can always get a loan if you own a home. In today's market unless you have enough funding to maintain. It is best to buy land and a home and get the equity off the home and that will substain you over time. It is best for me (Company Stock Holders) to buy a house and than a RV

So i need to have land and a house, Now houses today are very expensive, \$800k and up however to have a business i need land and a home.

Now, i need a place to park the truck. Now the big sleeper comes into play. I could get a 180" Big Sleeper



and haul general freight. I could make money as working from home.

Construction Market is 50/50 For instance. You need 7.000' of lumber. you have 6' - 8' - 10' - 12' - 16' lumber

Now if you buy

4"x4"x6' lumber at \$8.88 per board = 1,167 Board for \$10,362.96

4"x4"x8' lumber at \$10.28 per board = 875 Board for \$8,995.00

4"x4"x10' lumber at \$14.88 per board = 700 Boards for \$10,416.00

4"x4"x12' lumber at \$17.88 per board = 584 Boards for \$10,441.92

4"x4"x16' lumber at \$23.78 per board = 438 Boards for \$10,415.64

Now the inexperience customer will order 875 board of 4"x4"x8' because the cost is \$8,995.00 not knowing a bundle is 212 pieces in a bundle meaning = 4.13 bundles to meet the demand. Then you will have waist of lumber. If you have 7' Post you have 1' from each board = 875' / 6= 146 boards you could of saved and you spent an extra of \$1,296.48 then you have to pay for clean up as well. Not wise to buy this if you have experience in the industry. If you are a contractor it is extra bid in the job (pocket cash because he will charge you for a dumpster, labor cost, trucking cost. So you are paying 1.5 times or more for the lumber cost.

Now if you buy the 12' Lumber and you have 7' post you have 5' of post you could use. You could use the 5' Post and cut it at 4' and use the 4' into the concrete tube and use a joist hangar for 3' extention and you have 1' waste x = 584 boards = 584 / 12' Lumber = 49 board = \$876.12 in waste plus clean up cost

Now if i buy the 16' lumber. I need a trailer to hold 16' Lumber or pay to have it delivered. Then i have 7' post. I can make 2 post with one board and have 2' waste on each board. $2' \times 438' = 876'$ total waste / 16' = 55 board = \$1,307.90 in waste plus clean up cost

The owner is looking at installation cost not waste cost. So it is best to have less waste cost to elimate additional charges on the back end. The waste cost the homeowner is not expecting to have. That how a contractor make his money.

Being the Delivery driver. I want the percentage of the gross commodity. So i will say 12' Boards is best for the job.

The Construction Company is saying 8' boards is best. One cut and the 1' Waste on the higher quantity of boards is best. I get paid twice.

The former is saying 10' Boards. The 3' Waste i could used in the concrete tube with Joist Hanger inside the concrete and i can finished the job before deadline. Less clean up and repairs to the property.

Now, do you see how small contractor make their money. They give you a rate for material. You choose the lowest rate and the highest clean up rate.

Now, when the encomony is in the situation right now. The homeowner says it cost me me \$9,000.00 in material to his neighbor and the neighbor has paid \$10,500.00 and they said you got rob. Then you say what was your labor cost for the job. You paid overall less his money went into labor and clean up. In which you got done faster and saved money.


Now, do you see construction is slow the country in a whole is in trouble.

Now it is best to buy a house to get the equity you do in fixing your home in case you sell it. You will not get more for the RV than what you paid for it new unless it is a classic and you had it for generation to generation.

Big sleeper and heavy haul is best to start. Homeownwer is getting rob and don't even know it they only see material cost.

A concrete Mix Pallet hold 42 bags x 80 lbs. = 3,360 lbs. + 40 lbs. Pallet = 3.400 lbs.

Normal Shipping is 42,000 lbs. / 3,400 lbs. pallet = 12 pallets

12 pallets x 42 bags = 504 Bags

504 Bags x \$5.98 per bag = \$3,013.92 Gross Commodity

\$3,013.92 Gross Commodity / 12.5% Brokering Gross Income = \$376.74 per load. How far will \$300.00 go in Logistics

Today's Flatbed Trendslines is \$2,66 per mile (\$376.74 per load / \$2.66 per mile = 141 Miles delivery)

If Trump impose a tariff on Portugal Belgium Blocks and concrete into this country. It goes to the Federal Government not to Logistics shipping. So the rate of jobs increase. When the construction cost is unbalance. It will take Jesus Logistics to fix the budget. (Strong and Severe Storms) When the supply of construction material is high and the demand for work is low. That when we are in a recession. The people can't afford the prices of labor. So To make remodeling more affordable now Construction machines are

remote control and electric to reduce the operation cost to make remodeling more affordable for small business owners. Renting Smaller Equipment and hiring more labors to do more manual labor to give jobs. That when Border Control comes into play. People working under State wages and hurting the small business owners.

All these comes into play when starting a business in today's market. If no construction than war is next. To reduce the population to have a Supply of jobs with a demand of people. That is when the market pays more per hour to employees because no one is available.




