Preamble

We, the undersigned, as free citizens of these United States and humble servants of Almighty God, do recognize that the preservation of liberty, the defense of justice, and the survival of our Republic are impossible apart from the providence, authority, and blessing of the Living God.

We acknowledge with reverence that this nation was conceived in the light of biblical truth, built upon the foundation of faith, and preserved through the sacrifices of countless patriots — but that today, America stands at a crossroads.

We have witnessed the decay of morality, the betrayal of public trust, the perversion of justice, and the silencing of truth. Our families, our children, our freedoms, and our future stand under relentless assault — not merely by political enemies, but by the spiritual forces of wickedness that oppose all righteousness.

Therefore, in the spirit of our forefathers and under the supreme authority of Jesus Christ, we proclaim this Covenant — not as a mere political statement, but as a sacred vow to restore, defend, and consecrate this Republic once more to God Almighty.

We enter into this Covenant not with presumption, but with repentance; not with empty words, but with the full weight of duty, honor, and faith.

For the sake of our nation, our children, and the glory of God, we declare:



In the Year of Our Lord 2025, mindful of the blessings bestowed upon this land by Almighty God, and burdened by the undeniable decline of our nation through corruption, godlessness, and betrayal, we — the people of these United States — do hereby declare and reaffirm the covenant between God, the American people, and this Republic.

Whereas, the foundation of this nation was laid upon faith in Jesus Christ, acknowledgment of Divine Providence, and the belief that all men are created equal and endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights;

Whereas, the framers of our Constitution understood that liberty without virtue, and freedom without faith, lead only to decay and destruction;

Whereas, the current state of our nation reflects abandonment of this sacred foundation, evidenced by lawlessness in government, moral corruption in our institutions, betrayal of the family, exploitation of the innocent, and the silencing of truth;

Whereas, we recognize that no political party, worldly power, or human scheme can save America apart from a return to the Living God, the Author of liberty and justice;

Therefore, let it be declared, solemnly and without compromise:

- I. That Jesus Christ is Lord over these United States — above every government, court, and earthly authority.*
- II. That the rights of the people come from God alone — not from legislatures, bureaucracies, or global powers.*
- III. That America shall return to the moral order established by Almighty God — rejecting lawlessness, wickedness, and perversions of truth.*
- IV. That we shall restore justice rooted in righteousness — where the innocent are protected, the guilty held accountable, and the rule of law serves the people, not the powerful.*
- V. That the family — designed by God — is the cornerstone of a free and virtuous society, and shall be defended from all attacks, foreign and domestic.*



VI. *That our children shall be safeguarded from indoctrination, exploitation, and spiritual assault, and shall be raised to know truth, courage, and the fear of God.*

VII. *That we reject the tyranny of globalism, the deceit of corruption, and the erosion of American sovereignty.*

VIII. *That we, as a people, shall walk humbly, courageously, and in repentance before God — seeking His mercy, His guidance, and His blessing for this Republic.*

To this end, we pledge ourselves — as citizens, families, leaders, and believers — to stand, to speak, and to act.

We do not make this covenant lightly, nor for political gain, but as an act of obedience to the God of our fathers, the Judge of the nations, and the Defender of liberty.

We understand that to restore America requires sacrifice. It requires courage. It requires faith unshaken by the threats of men or the schemes of tyrants.

But we stand resolute.

We stand as a people consecrated to truth.

We stand as a Republic returning to righteousness.

We stand under the banner of Jesus Christ — the only true hope for this nation.

In the presence of Almighty God, before our fellow citizens, and for the generations yet unborn, we hereby declare and affirm this Covenant — for the restoration of the Republic, the defense of the people, and the glory of God.

So help us God.
