- If the start of school is delayed, the CAS before school program is closed.
- If elementary, middle, or high schools are dismissed early for an emergency, CAS is closed.

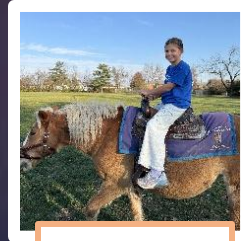
