SCHOOL/CAS CLOSINGS

EMERGENCY DELAYS, DISMISSALS & CLOSINGS: Schools are sometimes closed for emergency conditions such as snowstorms, facility problems, etc. In these situations: *o If Worthington Schools are closed for the day, CAS is closed.*

- o If the start of school is delayed, the CAS before school program is closed.
- o If the elementary, middle, or high schools are dismissed early for an emergency, CAS is closed.

Parents must make alternate arrangements for days when CAS is closed and ensure their child is aware of the plan. Please keep an eye and ear out for school closing information.
