2025-26 REGISTRATION, ENROLLMENT, & TOITION

Priority registration for the 2025-26 school year will be March 3 - 9. Instructions and reminders will be emailed leading up to the registration window. Registration is required if you want your child to attend next school year. Tuition to secure enrollment and cover August tuition will be half of a standard monthly payment and due May 15th.

Monthly tuition rates for the 2025-26 school year will increase \$10/month for the PM program, as follows:

Full-time: \$290 Part-time 3 days/week: \$240 Part-time 2 days/week: \$200
