#### Minutes of the Brown Township Board Meeting, February 15, 2024

Shari O'Riley called the meeting to order.

Roll call was taken, members in attendance: Mr. Jim Murphy, Mrs. Shari O'Riley, Mr. Kevin Rogers and Mrs. Angela Delp.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

The first item of business was citizen comments. There were none.

Next item of business was the minutes from the last meeting. Motion to approve meeting minutes made by Mr. Rogers; motion seconded by Mr. Murphy. Minutes from the last meeting were approved and signed.

The 2023 Annual Financial Report was handed out.

Mrs. Delp presented the information regarding the creation of the website, how much everything cost and the conflict-of-interest disclosure statement to Mr. Murphy.

Mr. Murphy had some questions regarding the financial report. Mr. Murphy asked if Mrs. Delp could find out what the initial principle of the bond was. The Chief said that one bond was paid off in 2023 and the other will be paid off at the beginning of 2025.

Mr. Rogers made a motion to adopt the 2023 Financial Report, Mr. Murphy seconded the motion. The motion was approved to adopt the 2023 Financial Report. The form was signed by the members of the board.

Next new business was Resolution 2024-1 Annual Assistance Guidelines. Mrs. Delp explained that the only thing that was changing from the 2023 Assistance Guidelines was the income limits being adjusted. Mr. Murphy had some questions regarding Table B.

A motion was made by Mr. Rogers to approve Resolution 2024-1; Mr. Murphy seconded the motion. Resolution 2024-1 was passed by the board.

Resolution 2024-2 Antinepotism was presented. Mr. Murphy made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-2, the motion was seconded by Mr. Rogers. Resolution 2024-2 was passed and signed by board members.

Resolution 2024-3 Adoption of the State Board of Accounts Uniform Internal Control Activities was presented. Mr. Rogers made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-3, the motion was seconded by Mr. Murphy. Resolution 2024-3 was passed and signed by board members.

Resolution 2024-4 Credit/Debit Card Policy was presented. Mr. Murphy asked about a \$500 limit for the card. He stated it should be known that there is a \$500 limit. It was noted on the resolution. Mr. Rogers made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-4, the motion was seconded by Mr. Murphy. Resolution 2024-4 was passed and signed by board members.

Mr. Murphy asked if the board and trustee comments could be moved up on the agenda. Mr. Murphy was given the floor. He wanted people to be aware of some concerns he had regarding the relocation of the Fire Territory Headquarters. He referenced a document he created that stated his opinions on the issue and asked people to share with their friends and neighbors. He read some of the information from the document he created regarding tax increases and the cost. Mrs. Delp asked Mr. Murphy where he got his numbers that he stated on the document. Mr. Murphy said he got them from various comments made by the chief. Mr. Murphy stated that he sent out 5-6 of the documents, expecting to get some response but he did not get any. Mrs. Delp stated that she also did not get any response from it.

Mrs. Delp stated that roughly 50% of Brown Township's money is spent on operations. Mr. Patterson and she are going to conduct a financial analysis to see if it is beneficial to merge Brown and Lincoln Townships. This is also the year where the Interlocal will have to be opened because we need to go from a Safety Board to a Merit Board, making it a good year to look at what changes need to be made to be more fiscally conservative. Mrs. O'Riley asked how long the analysis would take. Mrs. Delp stated she hasn't spoken to an accountant yet. She wanted to make the board aware prior to formally doing it. Mr. Murphy asked if this has been done before in the state of Indiana. Mrs. Delp answered that yes it has.

Mrs. O'Riley thanked Mr. Murphy for putting his document out there. She stated that she has concerns with putting out information and not having resources to cite, stating it would be helpful to know where the information came from. Mrs. O'Riley stated that she would have liked for the board to discuss it before it went out. Mr. Murphy stated that he had asked the Trustee in the past to put the word out and she was not agreeable to it. Mrs. Delp stated that she was not agreeable to a bulk mailer.

The floor was opened to citizen comments.

Fire Chief Alcorn responded to the things listed in Mr. Murphy's document. He mentioned that not everyone will see a tax increase. He stated the amount listed in Mr. Murphy's document, \$8M is just for the building. The building and training grounds will be more like \$12M. Mr. Murphy and Chief Alcorn discussed the taxes involved. Chief Alcorn brought up the fact that the Washington Township firehouse does not meet their needs and his job is to make sure the building Brownsburg Fire Territory builds needs to be adequate for their needs for now and years to come. Chief Alcorn stated that there have been no votes or no motions regarding the issue, it's just been a general discussion.

Mr. Murphy and Chief Alcon continued to discuss Mr. Murphy's questions regarding the Fire Territory.

Mr. Tinkey asked if there was any analysis done on insurance rates. Chief Alcorn said they are graded, and the next grade will take place 4 years from now. Mrs. Delp stated that she asked her insurance company and was told it would not affect insurance rates for the residential side, it would only affect the commercial side.

Mr. Murphy asked if we have an interlocal agreement with Zionsville, Chief Alcorn stated that he did not believe so but would have to check.

Mrs. O'Riley asked for a motion to close the meeting. Mr. Murphy made a motion and Mr. Rogers seconded it.

Meeting was adjourned.
