1. Discussion and approval of Resolution 2022-05 establishing the Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. - 2. Discussion and approval to purchase temporary speed bumps and signage not to exceed \$5000. - 4. Discussion of nuisance abatement ordinances. Mayor Rice will mail copies of the City Ordinances regulating nuisance properties.
- 5. Discussion and approval of building permits for 910 Park Avenue. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by D. Smith and seconded by T. Huber. Roll Call: C. Gilbert aye, S. Perry aye, D. Smith aye. S. Rice abstained from voting due to a conflict of interest because of her status as property owner. The motion was approved.
- 6. Discussion and approval of all February 8, 2022 council meeting and public hearing minutes. Mayor Rice asked if there were any changes to the meeting minutes. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by T. Huber and seconded by D. Smith Roll Call: C. Gilbert aye, S. Perry aye, S. Rice aye. The motion was approved.
