Dear Mr. Rice,

Brandt Construction Co. will provide the necessary materials, labor, and equipment to apply one coat of seal oil and aggregate on Park Avenue and North Street in the amount of nineteen thousand five hundred eighty-five dollars and no cents (\$19,585.00). Application rates are based on Iowa DOT specifications as well as all material will meet IADOT certification.

As an alternate option, we will install 3 asphalt speed bumps in the amount of four thousand dollars and zero cents (\$4,000.00) per each bump for a total of \$12,000.00. We can also include advance "Bump" signs for \$480.00/each. You will need two "Bump" signs per each bump for a total of 6 each x \$480.00 equals \$2,880.00.




Figure 3.10.7. Sample Design for Speed Hump (Source: Delaware Department of Transportation)
