COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES MAY 10, 2022 – 6:30 PM

The City Council of Panorama Park, Iowa met in a regular session at 6:30 PM, Tuesday, May 10, 2022 in City Hall.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Rice called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. A quorum was reached.

AGENDA APPROVAL

Discussion and approval of the council meeting agenda for Tuesday, May 10, 2022. Mayor Rice asked if there were any other changes to the meeting agenda. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by S. Rice and seconded by T. Huber. Roll Call: C. Gilbert - aye, S. Perry - aye, S. Rice - aye, D. Smith - aye. The motion was approved.

PRESENTATIONS

Steve Mosteller, Senior Account Representative for gWorks presented the benefits of their SimpleCity accounting software via a Google Meets teleconference call.

PUBLIC COMMENTS TO THE COUNCIL

- Matt Stutenberg, Industrial Technology Teacher for Pleasant Valley High School, to discuss the siding mix-up for the storage shed. The Council unanimously voted to accept the tan siding. S. Rice recused herself from the vote due to her employment by the Pleasant Valley Community School District.
- 2. Betty Leach, resident, inquired about driveway requirements and asked for information about the sanitary sewer and gas connections to her home. She was advised to contact OneCall location services.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

S. Rice stated that the community garage sale would be held June 10 and 11. The annual Spring Cleanup will be June 13. S. Rice stated that a newsletter will go out in the next two weeks to inform the residents. The newsletter is also to include information on speeding, speed humps, lawn mowing, junk cars, and loose dogs.

<u>DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL</u> of the bid proposal to purchase gWorks SimpleCity accounting software with payment no sooner than July 1, 2022. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by S. Rice and seconded by S. Perry. Roll Call: C. Gilbert - aye, T. Huber - aye, D. Smith - aye. The motion was approved.

<u>DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL</u> of the contract to construct three (3) speed humps on Park Avenue and to resurface Park Avenue and North Street. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by T. Huber and seconded by S. Perry. Roll Call: C. Gilbert - aye, S. Rice - aye, D. Smith - aye. The motion was approved.

<u>DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL</u> of the bid proposal to construct a fence at City Hall. The Council expressed concern about the cost of the bids that were received. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *No motion was made. All bids were rejected.*

<u>DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL</u> of the bid proposals for mowing City Hall and 105 2nd Street. The Council expressed concern about the cost of the bids that were received. D. Smith, C. Gilbert, and Mayor Rice volunteered to mow the properties. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *No motion was made. All bids were rejected.*

<u>DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL</u> of the invoice for snow removal from the City of Bettendorf. Several Council Members expressed their satisfaction with the quality of the snow removal for this past winter. Hearing no additional comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *A motion was made by S. Perry and seconded by D. Smith Roll Call: C. Gilbert - aye, T. Huber - aye, S. Rice - aye. The motion was approved.*
