RESOLUTION 2022-08 authorizing Mayor Rice to approve the amendment to the 28E agreement with the City of Bettendorf for FY2023 snow removal services. Mayor Rice stated that the agreement is identical to the 28E approved by the Council last year. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *Roll Call: C. Gilbert - aye, T. Huber - aye, S. RESOLUTION 2022-09 authorizing Mayor Rice to approve Amendment 1 to the agreement with MSA Professional Services for Phase 1 of the Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project.
