RESOLUTION OF PANORAMA PARK, IOWA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND TREASURER TO TRANSFER \$125,000.00 FROM THE GREAT SOUTHERN BANK SAVINGS ACCOUNT FOR INVESTMENT IN A \$125,000.00 CERTIFICATE OF DEPOSIT WITH GREAT SOUTHERN BANK FOR THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, the Panorama Park City Council would like to maximize the value of excess assets; and,

WHEREAS, the Treasurer has determined that excess money is available for investment; and,

WHEREAS, the Treasurer recommends purchasing a Certificates of Deposit (CD) to be valued at one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000.00), at a rate of approximately 4.15% APY, and for a period of eleven (11) months from Great Southern Bank; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Panorama Park have reviewed the investment policy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Panorama Park City Council, that Mayor Christopher Gilbert and Treasurer Gary Gleason are directed to transfer \$125,000.00 from the Great Southern Bank Savings Account and purchase a Certificate of Deposit from Great Southern Bank in the amount of \$125,000.00 for the General Fund.
