RESOLUTION OF PANORAMA PARK, IOWA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND TREASURER TO TRANSFER \$140,000.00 FROM THE FAMILY CREDIT UNION SAVINGS ACCOUNT SEWER FUND FOR INVESTMENT IN A \$140,000.00 CERTIFICATE OF DEPOSIT WITH THE FAMILY CREDIT UNION FOR THE SEWER FUND.

WHEREAS, the Panorama Park City Council would like to maximize the value of excess assets; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Treasurer has determined that excess money is available for investment; and,

WHEREAS, the Treasurer recommends purchasing a Certificate of Deposit (CD) to be valued at one hundred and forty thousand dollars (\$140,000.00), at a rate of approximately 4.75% APY, and for a period of six (6) months from The Family Credit Union; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Panorama Park have reviewed the investment policy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Panorama Park City Council, that Mayor Ronald Rice and Clerk/Treasurer Christopher Gilbert are directed to transfer \$140,000.00 from the Family Credit Union Savings Account Sewer Fund and purchase a Certificate of Deposit from the Family Credit Union in the amount of \$140,000.00 for the Sewer Fund.
