The City Council of the City of Panorama Park, Scott County, Iowa was scheduled to meet in Regular Session in the Council Chambers of the City Hall at 6:00 PM on the 12th day of February Mayor Ronald Rice presiding.

Motion presented by B. Elmore to approve the consent agenda including: February Meeting Agenda, January 17, 2018 Meeting Minutes, January Expenses, and January Treasurer's Report, seconded by J. Krause. Motion carried (4 Ayes, 0 Nays).

<u>C - Public Comments to the Council</u>

Gary Gleason commented on the use of a "Consent Agenda" at his previous employer AEA and how it saved time.

Mayor asked the Council members to review items on the "Consent Agenda" prior to the meeting and ask questions prior to the meeting so the Clerk can research and come prepared to answer questions.

Discussion to appoint Jeffrey McDaniel as City Attorney. Mr. McDaniel's Law Firm will not charge a retainage. The City will be invoiced \$147.00/\$staff hr, this rate applies to all staff in his firm. Motion by M. Lauritzson to appoint Jeffrey McDaniel City Attorney at the billing rate of \$147.00/\$staff hr, seconded by S. Rice. Motion carried (4 Ayes, 0 Nays).

Correction to the January Meeting Minutes, they should have included the adoption of the new meeting rules as developed and presented at the meeting. Motion by D. White to approve Ordinance 2018-02 Panorama Park Meeting Rules, seconded by M. Lauritzson. Motion carried (4 Ayes, 0Nays).

<u>E - New Business</u>

The Mayor presented a quote for a replacement HVAC system. The current heating system does not stay on and must be checked multiple times a day. Motion by S. Rice to accept

the bid for \$4,700.00 from Bettendorf Heating and Cooling, seconded by J. Krause. Motion carried (4 Ayes, 0 Nays).

The Mayor created and presented a new City "logo" for Council input. Council reviewed, no action at this time.
