### Call to Order

Mayor Rice called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m. A quorum was reached.

### Agenda Approval

Discussion and approval of the Property Tax Levy Hearing Agenda for Saturday, February 8, 2020. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or changes regarding the agenda and hearing none, asked for a motion to approve. *A motion was made by S. Rice, seconded by S. Perry to approve the Agenda as presented. With no further discussion, Roll Call: T. Huber-Aye, D. Smith-Aye. The agenda was approved.* 

### **Presentations**

Council viewed the League of Cities video on Senate File 634, new rules on property tax levies. Treasurer, Gary Gleason, explained how the new rules will affect the city's budget process.

Mayor Rice presented data on how property values have dropped. The mayor proposed a 1.95 percent levy increase in order to make up for the revenue shortfall. The proposed increase would keep the property tax levy below 6% of taxable assessed valuation. This would result in an average increase of approximately \$8.55 per property for fiscal year 2021.

S. Perry asked for clarification about the proposed levy numbers. The council discussed whether any budgetary items could be trimmed and determined that the proposed budget was sound.
