July 11, 2020 – 9:00 a.m.

The City Council of Panorama Park, Iowa met in regular session at 9:00 a.m., Saturday, June 13, 2020.

In Attendance: S. Perry, S. Rice, D. White Council Members Absent: T. Huber, D. Smith Also Present: Mayor Ronald Rice, Treasurer Gary Gleason, Sheriff Dept. Sgt. Loge, Residents Eric and Susie Nichol. Presiding: Mayor Ronald Rice

Call to Order

Mayor Rice called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. A quorum was reached.

Agenda Approval

Discussion and approval of Council Meeting Agenda for Saturday, July 11, 2020. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or changes regarding the agenda. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *A motion was made by S. Perry and seconded by D. White. Roll Call: S. Rice aye. The motion was approved.*

Public Comments to the Council

Eric and Susie Nichol, 119 2nd Street: The Nichol's presented the background for an on-going dispute with an adjacent Bettendorf resident about dead end parking at the end of 2nd Street. Sgt. Loge presented the Scott County Sheriff Department's involvement and stated that the county considers the case closed. The city agreed to take the situation under advisement.

Mayor's Report

- Mayor Rice stated that additional bids for snow removal have not been obtained.
- Mayor Rice presented three bids for jetting and rooting the sanitary sewer system: Kline \$2.50/ft.; Environmark \$1.50/ft.; Kline \$2.50/ft. Mayor Rice will request more detailed bids before the council votes to select a contractor.
- Mayor Rice updated the council on city street repairs. Tri-City Blacktop can't proceed until the Bettendorf portions of Park Avenue and North Street have been completed.

Committee Reports

- Big Garbage Cleanup is scheduled for July 13. A flyer has been distributed and information has been posted on the website and message boards.
- Summer Reading Challenge- S. Rice distributed books and has given out the first award for the reading challenge.
- Mayor Rice wondered if the city could provide can collection and use the funds for public events. S. Rice will solicit information from other cities who offer this service.

Unfinished Business

1. Discussion on bids for hydroseeding (grass) North Street and Park Avenue ditches. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *No motion was made. The motion failed.*

- Discussion of on-street parking on city streets. Reviewed current ordinances and discussed possible changes to remediate dispute at the end of Second Street. S. Perry will contact the Bettendorf homeowner about possible changes to parking ordinances and invite the homeowner to the next council meeting. Mayor Rice will send a letter to the Bettendorf homeowner inviting her to the next council meeting.

Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *A motion was made by D. White and seconded by S. Rice. Roll Call: S. Perry abstained. The motion was approved.*
