COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES September 12, 2020 – 9:00 a.m.

The City Council of Panorama Park, Iowa met in regular session at 9:00 a.m., Saturday, September 12, 2020.

In Attendance: T. Huber, S. Perry, S. Rice, D. White

Council Members Absent: D. Smith

Also Present: Mayor Ronald Rice, Treasurer Gary Gleason, Betty Leach, Jennifer Frantz, Jacob Lund

Presiding: Mayor Ronald Rice

Call to Order

Mayor Rice called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. A guorum was reached.

Agenda Approval

Discussion and approval of Council Meeting Agenda for Saturday, September 12, 2020. Mayor Rice asked if there were any other questions or changes regarding the agenda. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by S. Rice and seconded by S. Perry. Roll Call: T. Huber - aye, D. White - aye. The motion was approved.

Public Comments to the Council

Betty Leach expressed concern about her neighbor's tree that was damaged by a recent storm. Ms. Leach cleaned up the debris that fell on her property and damaged the roof of her home. Ms. Leach asked what action the Council could take regarding a broken branch that is lodged between two trees. City Attorney Jeff McDaniel suggested that Ms. Leach send a letter to notify her neighbor of the potential danger. Mayor Rice will also send a letter to request that the homeowner mitigate the hazard.

Presentations

City Attorney Jeff McDaniel made a presentation to the Council regarding Second Street parking issues. The existing 28E Agreement City of Bettendorf is a simple agreement to provide fire and rescue service. It does not contain any provisions or recommendations about on-street parking. Attorney McDaniel contacted the Bettendorf Fire Chief about Second Street access in an emergency. Chief Knorrek responded by mail and stated, "From the research that the Scott County Sheriff's Office and the Scott County Attorney's Office have done, it appears that there is no requirement for 5660 Valley Drive to have access to Second Street. The property has access from Valley Drive." Attorney McDaniel stated that it is within the authority of the Council to designate a dead-end street. The current lowa Code does not restrict the Council's authority to regulate parking and the Panorama Park Code of Ordinances does not limit parking on any city streets.

Mayor's Report

- Update on city street repairs. Mayor Rice stated that the repairs to Park Avenue, Short Street, and North Street have been completed. Mayor Rice does not believe that any more repairs will need to be done this year..
- Update on sanitary sewer system repairs. Mayor Rice hosted a meeting with Mayor Bawdin of Riverdale
 and Chris Cooper of MSA to suggest consolidating sanitary sewer repairs into a combined project. There
 could be significant cost savings by combining the projects. MSA will manage the project for both cities,
 but the billing could be handled separately. The Riverdale Clerk, Kent Royster will complete a draft 28E
 Agreement by December 1, 2020.

Committee Reports

S. Rice suggested that Panorama Park follow the Bettendorf guidelines for Halloween Trick or Treat. Once they are established by Bettendorf, the guidelines will be published in a newsletter and on the website.

- 1. Discussion and approval of Resolution 2020-12 accepting and approving the City Street Finance Report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020. Mayor Rice presented the supporting data and asked if there were any questions. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *A motion was made by S. Perry and seconded by D. White. Roll Call: T. Huber aye, S. Rice aye. The motion was approved.*
- 2. Discussion of on-street parking. On most occasions when cars are parked on-street, it is temporary. Emergency vehicles have limited room to maneuver on most streets, but they will do what they can to access homes regardless of whether cars are parked on the street or not. Adopting no-parking zones would require an ordinance change.
- 3. Discussion and approval of Resolution 2020-13 to install a road closed barrier on Second Street. Mayor Rice recommended that Second street be designated as a dead-end and for the appropriate signage be installed. Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by T. Huber and seconded by D. White. Roll Call: S. Perry aye, S. Rice aye. The motion was approved.
- 4. Discussion and approval of Resolution 2020-14 authorizing a 28E agreement with the City of Bettendorf for snow removal. Mayor Rice reviewed the details of the agreement and fielded questions. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by T. Huber and seconded by S. Perry. Roll Call: S. Rice aye, D. White aye. The motion was approved.
- 5. Discussion and approval of the minutes from the August 15, 2020 Council Meeting. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by S. Rice and seconded by D. White. Roll Call: T. Huber aye, S. Perry aye. The motion was approved.
- 6. Discussion and approval of monthly financial statements. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the financial statements. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by D. White and seconded by S. Perry. Roll Call: T. Huber aye, S. Rice aye. The motion was approved.
- 7. Discussion and approval for payment of outstanding bills. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the expenses. Hearing no comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by D. White and seconded by S. Rice. Roll Call: Tim Huber aye, S. Perry aye. The motion was approved.
