Call to Order

Mayor Rice called the meeting to order at 9:38 a.m. A quorum was reached.

Agenda Approval

Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or changes regarding the agenda. The presentation by Chris Cooper from MSA Professional Services was postponed. - 1. Discussion and approval of Resolution 2020-07 to accept the proposed FY2021 Budget. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the proposed budget. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *A motion was made by D. Smith and seconded by D. White. With no further discussion, Roll Call: S. Rice-aye, T. Huber-aye. The motion was approved.*
- 2. Discussion and approval of Resolution 2020-08 to reinvest CD's that mature on March 21, 2020. Mayor Rice explained that the balances would go in the savings account to pay expenses or be reinvested at a future date. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the resolution. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by T. Huber and seconded by D. Smith. With no further discussion, Roll Call: S. Rice-aye, D. White-aye. The motion was approved.
- 3. Discussion and approval to survey the boundaries for North Street. The council discussed that before improvements to North Street could be done, a survey would be needed. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by S. Rice and seconded by D. White. With no further discussion, Roll Call: D. Smith-aye, T. Huber-aye. The motion was approved.
- 4. Discussion and approval to excavate the drainage ditch for North Street. The council discussed that after the road is surveyed, excavating a ditch would prevent erosion to North Street. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions and hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by D. Smith and seconded by D. White. With no further discussion, Roll Call: S. Rice-aye, T. Huber-aye. The motion was approved.

- 5. Discussion of solutions to prevent mail theft. Mayor Rice referred to the previous council's proposal of locking mailbox banks on the city lot and at city hall. An informal poll of the residents and council present was conducted: five were opposed, four agreed. The council discussed having a drop box at the city hall for outgoing mail, since the mail theft was outgoing mail. S. Rice will ask the postmaster about the viability of the plan and report at the next meeting.
- 6. Discussion and approval of minutes from the February 8, 2020 FY2021 Property Tax Levy Meeting. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. *A motion was made by D. Smith and seconded by T. Huber. With no further discussion, Roll Call: S. Rice-aye, D. White-aye. The motion was approved.*
- 7. Discussion and approval of minutes from the February 8, 2020 Council Meeting. Mayor Rice asked if there were any questions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Rice called for a vote. A motion was made by D. Smith and seconded by D. White. With no further discussion, Roll Call: S. Rice-aye, T. Huber-aye. The motion was approved.

Mayor Rice reported that the payment to MSA was a payment to date, but the city would continue to pay for MSA services as the sewer project progressed. The motion was approved.
