Re: Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation - Phase 2

Dear Mayor Rice:

Enclosed is Pay Application 1 for the aforementioned project. MSA has reviewed all work above ground that is readily visible. MSA assumes that the work required to be completed prior to the construction of the cast-in-place-pipe was also completed, since the construction of this "lining" is now also complete. In fact, at this time, all the work is completed. MSA has held off on recommending payment on some insewer line items until the digital videos are made available for MSA to review.

MSA recommends payment to Visu-Sewer in the amount of \$42,969,50. Please let me know if there are any questions.

Also submitted with this letter is Change Order 1. This change order is for additional quantities that have been constructed. These items include 6 additional lineal feet of the cast-in-place lining in the sanitary sewers, 1 additional lateral grouting, and 347 lineal feet of sewer and lateral cleaning to remove debris. The additional 347 lineal feet is due to MSA's error in summing up the total quantities. This cleaning was required to remove the amount of accumulated mud in the sanitary laterals. The total amount of Change Order 1 is \$1,968.00. If approved by City Council, this will be paid as part of the next pay application. I hope the next pay application is within a week.

Part of the final project close out is obtaining lien waivers from the Sub-Contractors. Therefore, the sooner the City pays Visu-Sewer, the sooner Visu-Sewer can pay their sub-contractor, Hagerty Earthworks, to close out this project.
