As you know, every driver education instructor in Michigan is required to complete an approved professional development offering every two years during the 2-year cycle that corresponds with their instructor license renewal period. You can complete your professional development requirements from the comfort of home, and at your own speed and pace.

To register for one of courses:

1. Pick your course from the list below. Complete this form and scan/email the form to midriveredassociates@gmail.com.
2. Once we receive your registration form, PayPal will send you a link for you to pay your registration fee of \$40. PayPal will then notify us of your payment, and we will send you the course and instructions. By paying directly through PayPal, you no longer have to share your credit/debit card information with us. We believe this is safer.
3. Each course comes with homework (test/evaluation) that must be completed and returned to us.
4. Upon successful completion of the homework, the MI-DEA office will e-mail you a certificate of completion. Please keep the certificate of completion in a safe place for a period of two (2) years. You will need this certificate when you renew your instructor license with the Michigan Department of State.
