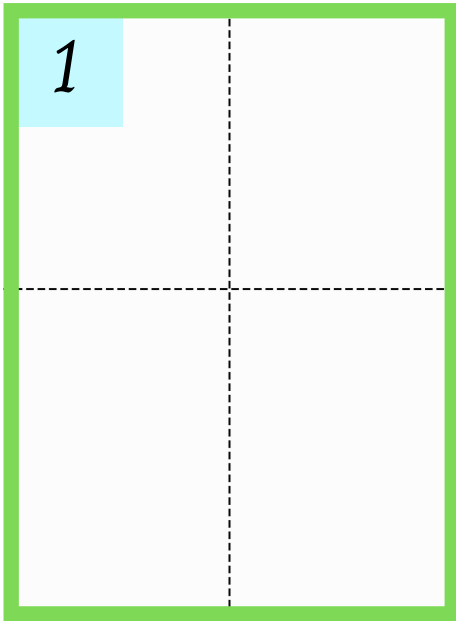
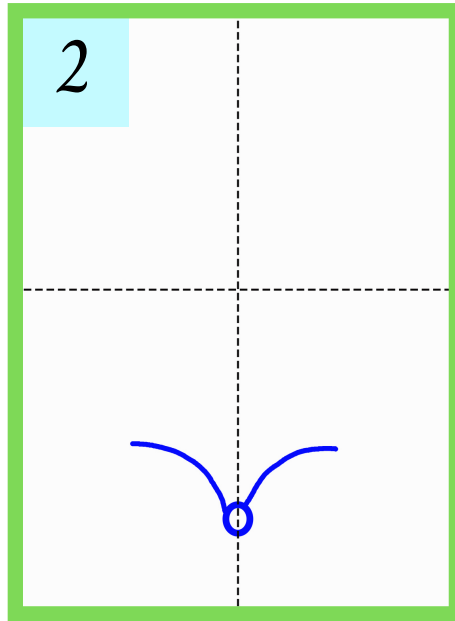


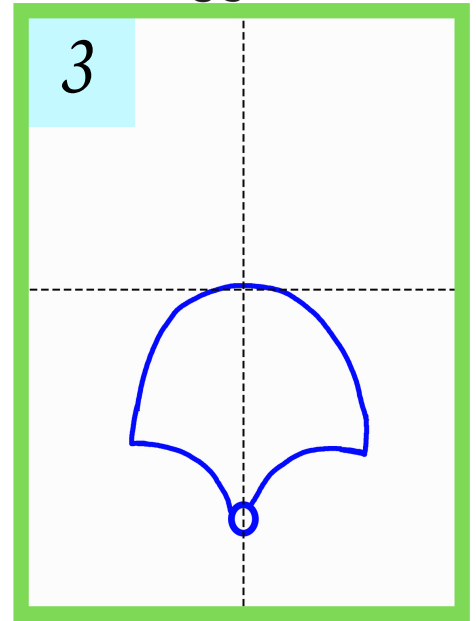
FABULOUS FOX



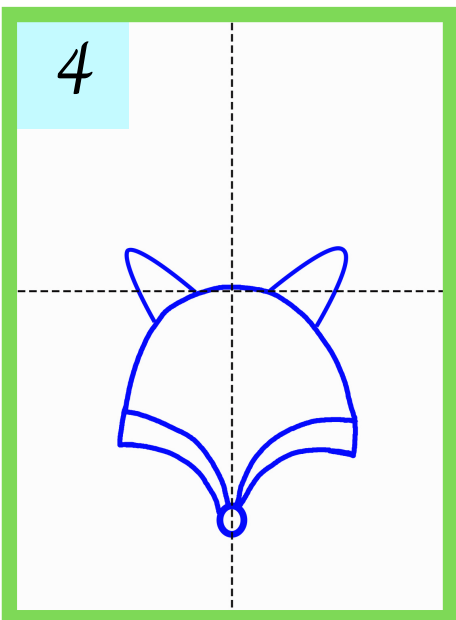
1
Divide your page into four using a pencil and a ruler. These are guidelines to help you draw your fox.



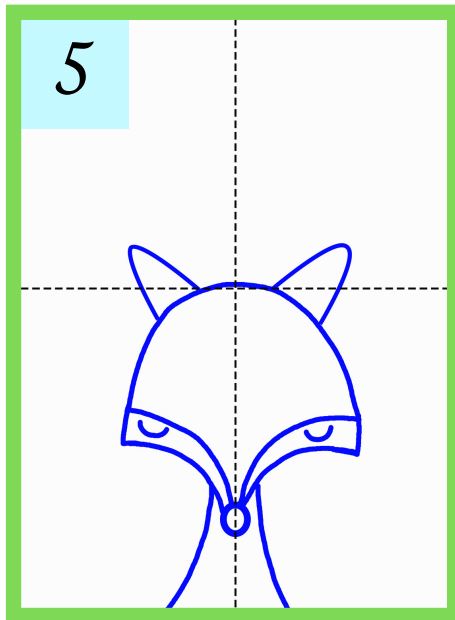
2
Use a pencil first to draw/sketch the guidelines, then go over the drawing with a marker or pen at the end.



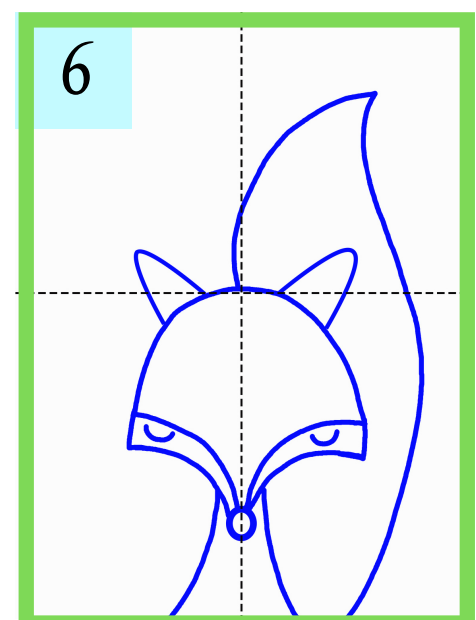
3
Connect the curved lines with a bigger curve for the head (touching the centre of the page).



4
Add curved lines inside the head shape, connecting to the nose. Then add some ears.

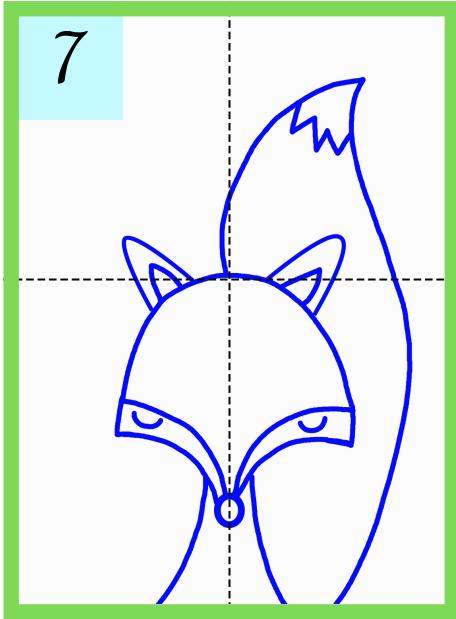


5
Add semicircles to create little closed eyes. Extend the body by adding a neck.

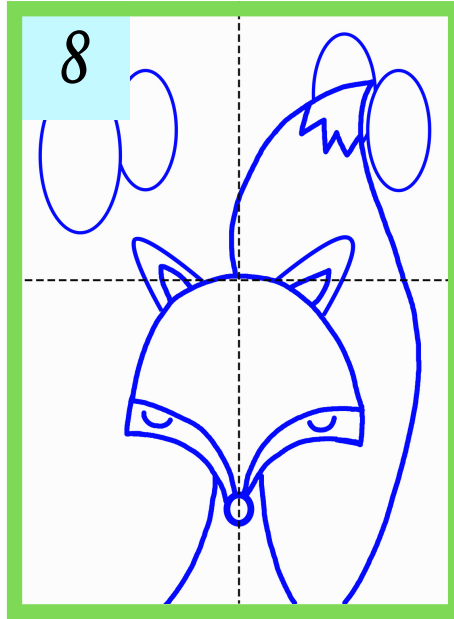


6
Draw a curved line from the top of the head - roughly from middle. Connect the top of the tail to the bottom of the page with a wavy line.

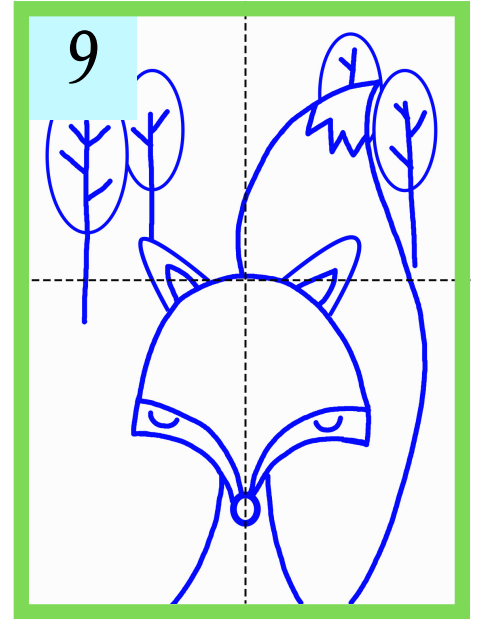

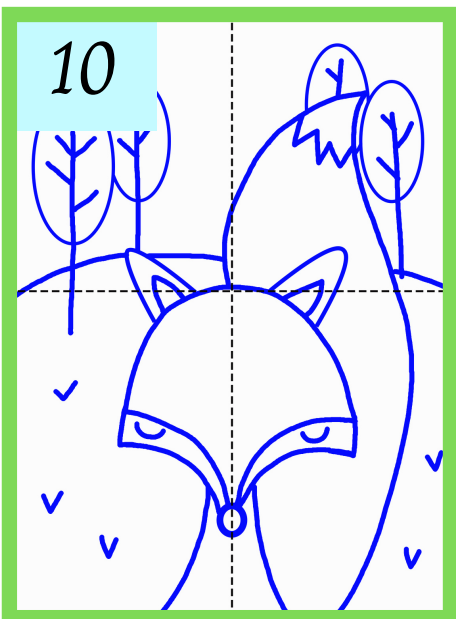
Draw some details for the tail (like zigzags). Then add some smaller triangles inside the ears.



Draw a few oval shapes in the top half of your page, in the background.



Complete the trees with branches and trunks.



Draw a horizon line at the back. Add some 'v' shapes for grass. Trace over your pencil lines with a black marker.



Add mountains and snow for a wintery feel. Colour your fox!
