- Entry deadline is September 20, 2025. Late entries may be accepted with a \$20.00 fee. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS.</u>
 All horse entries will be pre-judged at 9:30a.m.
- 4. Parade lineup is at 10:30 a.m. SHARP.
- 5. Parade starts at 11:00 a.m. SHARP.
- 6. <u>JUNIOR ENTRY</u> 18 years old & under. <u>SENIOR ENTRY</u> Over 18 years of age.
- 7. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. All parade awards will be presented at the Community Garden on Spink Road beginning with horse awards at approximately 1:00 p.m.

PARADE CATEGORIES Junior/Senior Judged Separately. WE OFFER ALL CSHA CATEGORIES

- 8. This is a **FORWARD MOTION PARADE**. Perform the entire parade route. <u>NO STOPPING AT JUDGES.</u>
- 9. All units <u>MUST</u> maintain 25 feet from unit ahead.
- 10. Entrants leaving the parade before the designated end of parade will be disqualified.
