

- 1. <u>NO ENTRY FEE</u> if parade entry is received by Sept 20, 2025, however donations are graciously accepted to help defray the cost of awards and expenses.
- ENTRY NUMBERS WILL BE MAILED Monday, September 24th. Place numbers on right side of entry.

  Entry deadline is September 20, 2025. Late entries may be accepted with a \$20.00 fee. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 3. All horse entries will be pre-judged at 9:30a.m.
- 4. Parade lineup is at 10:30 a.m. SHARP.
- 5. Parade starts at 11:00 a.m. SHARP.
- 6. <u>JUNIOR ENTRY</u>- 18 years old & under. <u>SENIOR ENTRY</u> Over 18 years of age.
- 7. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. All parade awards will be presented at the Community Garden on Spink Road beginning with horse awards at approximately 1:00 p.m.
- 8. This is a FORWARD MOTION PARADE. Perform the entire parade route. NO STOPPING AT JUDGES.
- 9. All units MUST maintain 25 feet from unit ahead.
- 10. Entrants leaving the parade before the designated end of parade will be disqualified.
- 11. Necessary parade categories will be added at the discretion of the Parade Chairman.
- 12. Entrants must have complete control of vehicles and/or animals at all times.
