DESCRIPTION AND USE

FABRIPATCH[®] H is a cement-based, acrylic-modified, versatile patching, repairing, levelling, and re-surfacing material designed to bond to a variety of cementitious and masonry substrates. While FABRIPATCH[®] H is primarily intended for use on horizon-tal surfaces, vertical applications are also possible. The product is ideally suited for use on ramps, stairs, walkways and concrete floors.

ADVANTAGES

The specially formulated polymer additive employed with FABRIPATCH[®] H not only imparts excellent compressive, tensile, flexural, and bond strengths, it also gives the product very high chemical resistance.

APPLICATION

Surfaces to be coated with FABRIPATCH[®] H must be clean and sound. All oil, grease, laitance, dirt and residual chemicals should be removed prior to application. Any loose or disintegrated material should be chipped away before beginning installation. Slightly dampen surfaces to be treated. Place a portion of the FABRIPATCH[®] H powder in a clean container and add sufficient FABRIPATCH[®] LIQUID RESIN to create a slurry mix. Brush this slurry mix on the surface to be patched. Add additional powder to the remainder of the slurry mix until a stiff mortar consistency is obtained. Trowel this mix into place. For patches deeper than 2 inches add 20 - 25 lbs of clean pea gravel per 50 lb pail of FABRIPATCH[®] H.

Care should be taken to avoid over trowelling as this could lead to separation.

CAUTION

FABRIPATCH[®] H is highly alkaline and is therefore irritating to eyes and skin. In case of contact, thoroughly flush with large amounts of water and call physician immediately. DO NOT RUB EYES. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not take internally. Keep out of reach of children. Keep product dry. Consult Material Safety Data Sheet before using this product.

LIMITATIONS

On re-surfacing projects, adequate allowance must be made for control and movement joints.

FABRIPATCH[®]H should not be applied in thicknesses greater than 1 inch without layering (scarifying the surface between layers).

FABRIPATCH[®]H must not be retempered nor be surface wetted to aid in trowelling.
