

## DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FOR PENDING BUILDING CODE OR ZONING ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

## NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE PURCHASER

The *Code of Virginia* (§ 55-519.2:1) requires the owner of residential real property who has **actual knowledge** of **(1)** any pending enforcement actions pursuant to the Uniform Statewide Building Code (§ 36-97 et seq.) that affect the safe, decent, sanitary living conditions of the property <u>of which the owner has been notified in writing</u> by the locality, or **(2)** any pending violation of the local zoning ordinance that the violator has <u>not</u> abated or remedied under the zoning ordinance, *within a time period set out in the written notice of violation* from the locality or established by a court of competent jurisdiction, the owner shall provide a written disclosure of that fact to the prospective purchaser.
