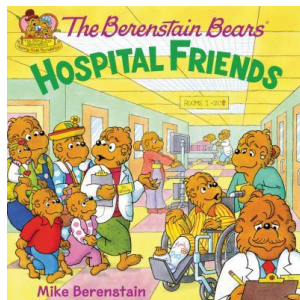

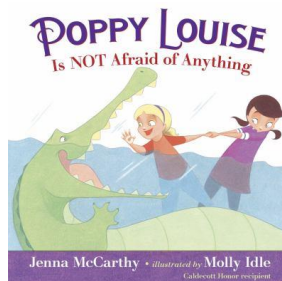

Vaught, Susan. When a bad storm drives all of the farm animals into the barn, can they set aside their fears and welcome wild animals, too?



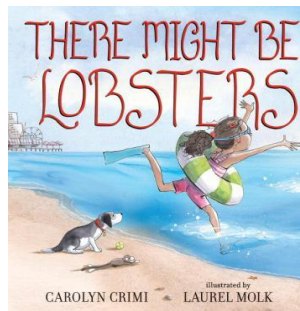

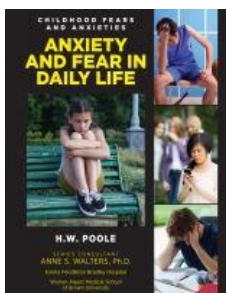
