- 3-Coats of paint using **US Open Paint and Materials**
- 2 Coats for Line Striping
- Re-Coating of Posts
- Net posts recoated to match the new surface.

## 1. Improves Playability

- Removes debris (leaves, dirt, sand) that can affect ball bounce and player footing.
- Restores the court's texture and grip, making the surface play more consistently.

## 2. Extends Court Life

- Prevents buildup of mold, mildew, and algae - common causes of surface damage.
- Reduces premature wear and breakdown of surfacing materials, especially on cushioned or acrylic courts.

## 3. Prevents Drainage Issues

- Keeps drains, edges, and surface slopes free of blockages.
- Minimizes standing water and puddles that lead to cracking or bubbling.



## 4. Enhances Appearance

- A clean court looks newer, more professional, and well-maintained - important for both private homeowners and public facilities.
- Helps preserve the vibrancy of surface colors.

## 5. Promotes Player Safety

- Removes slick substances like moss or algae that can cause slips and falls.
- Eliminates sharp debris (twigs, stones) that could cause injury.

## 6. Saves Money on Repairs

- Routine cleaning helps identify early signs of wear, such as cracking or bubbling, before they become major (and expensive) problems.
- Reduces frequency of resurfacing needed over time.

# Problems Using Non-Specialized Contractors

## 1. Improper Slope or Grade

General contractors often pour slabs that are too flat or uneven, leading to standing water, puddles, and surface damage.

## 2. Incorrect Dimensions & Layout

Courts must meet strict size regulations and have accurate lines, net post locations, and fencing spacing.

## 3. Surface Texture Too Smooth or Too Rough

Regular concrete finishers often trowel the surface too rough or smooth and the paint won't adhere properly.

## 4. No Use of Post-Tension Concrete

Regular installers typically use basic slab-on-grade pours, which crack and shift over time, ruining the court.

## 5. Improper Materials

Using the wrong mix or sealing too early can lead to coating failures like bubbling, peeling, popouts, leaching, or delamination.

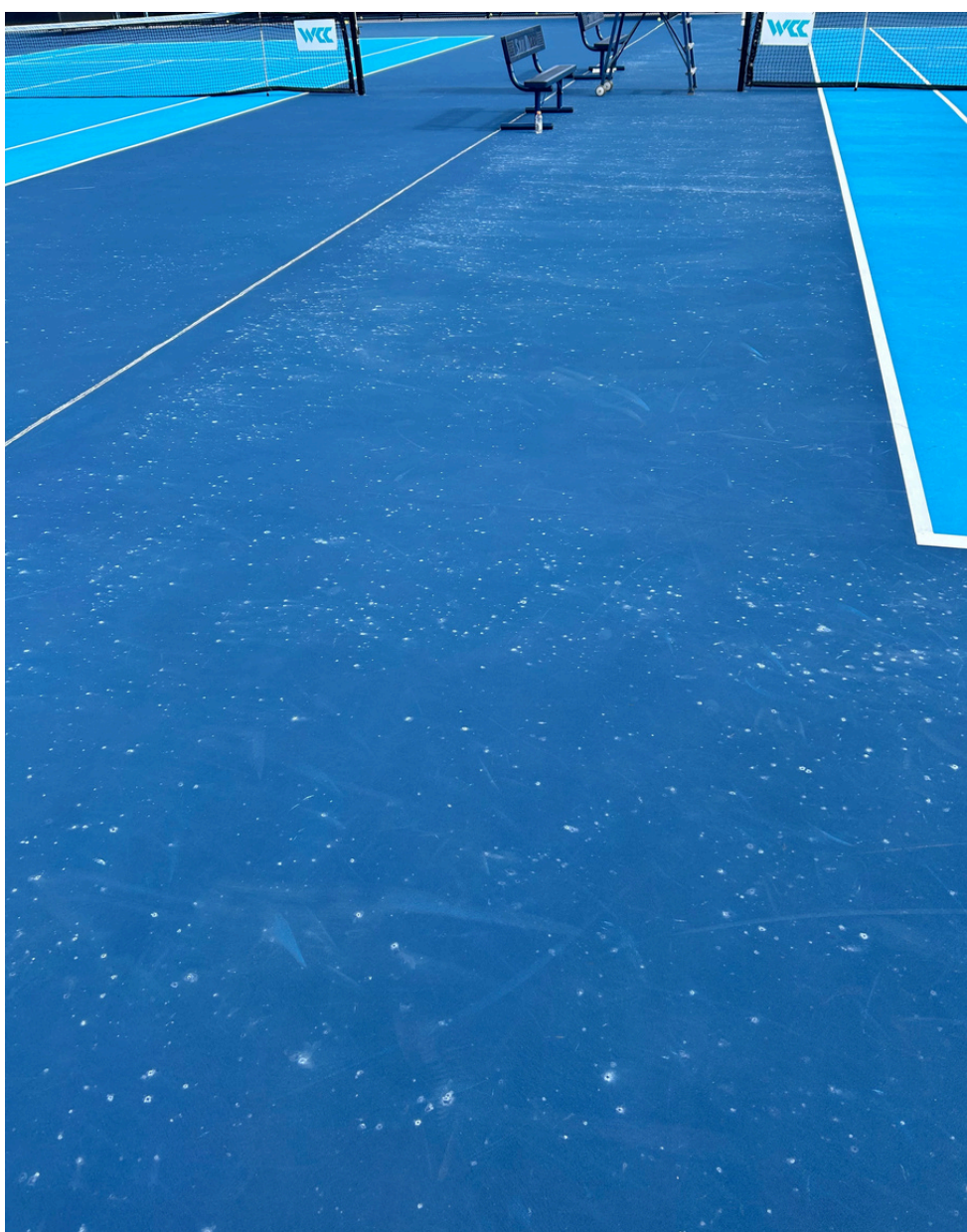
## 6. No Integration for Equipment

Standard crews often improperly install sleeves for net posts, lighting conduits, or fencing footings—requiring costly retrofits.

## 7. Surface not level

Most installers don't use proper leveling tools leaving many undulations or a "wavy" surface effecting both aesthetics and play.

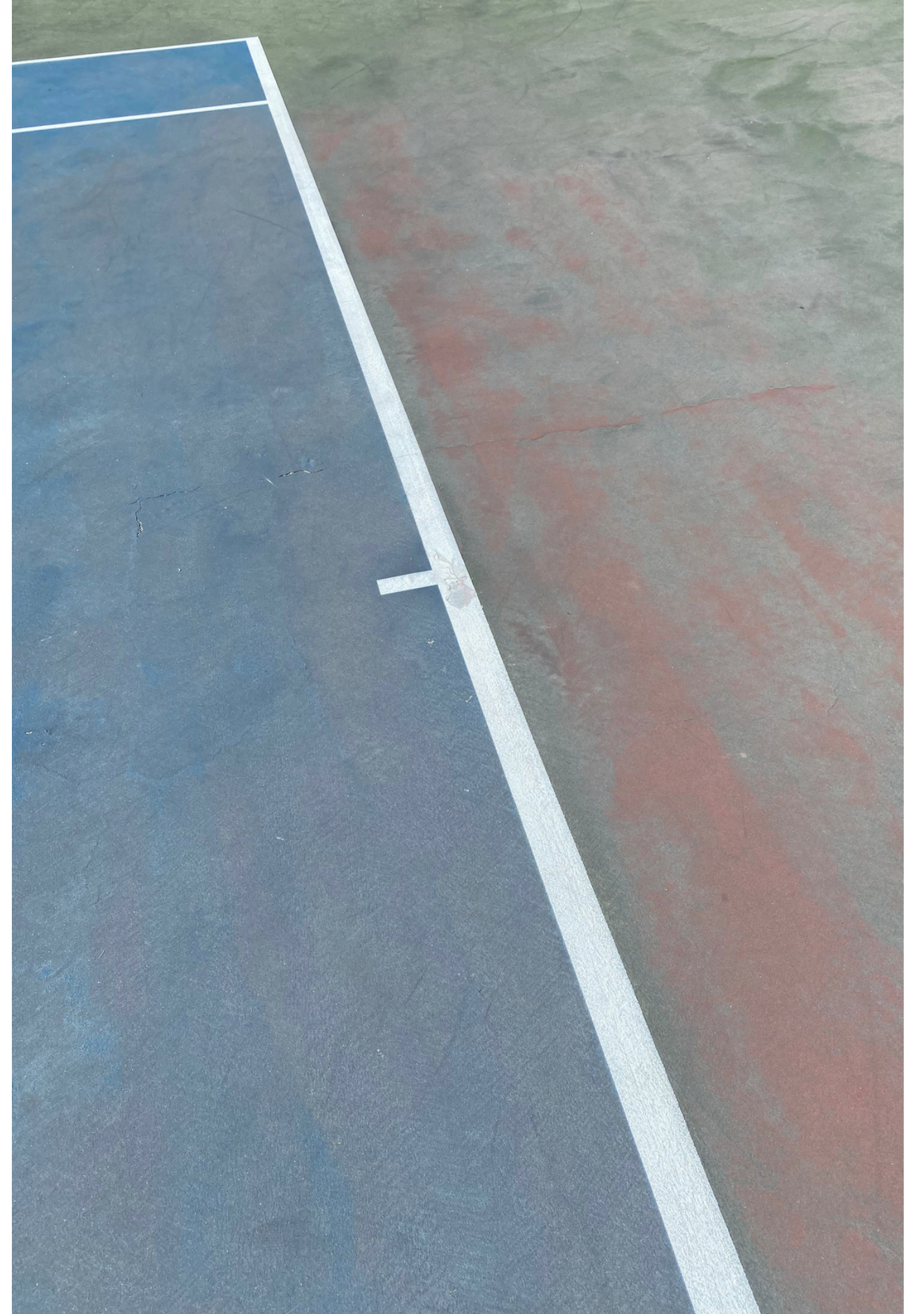

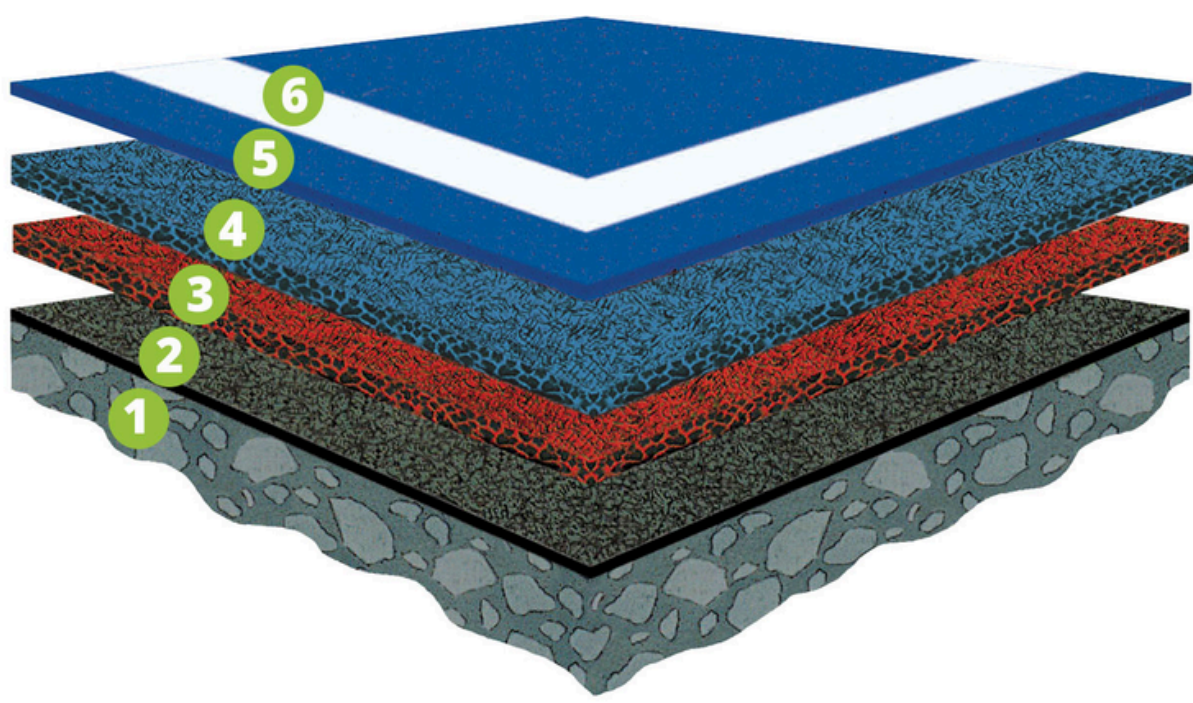

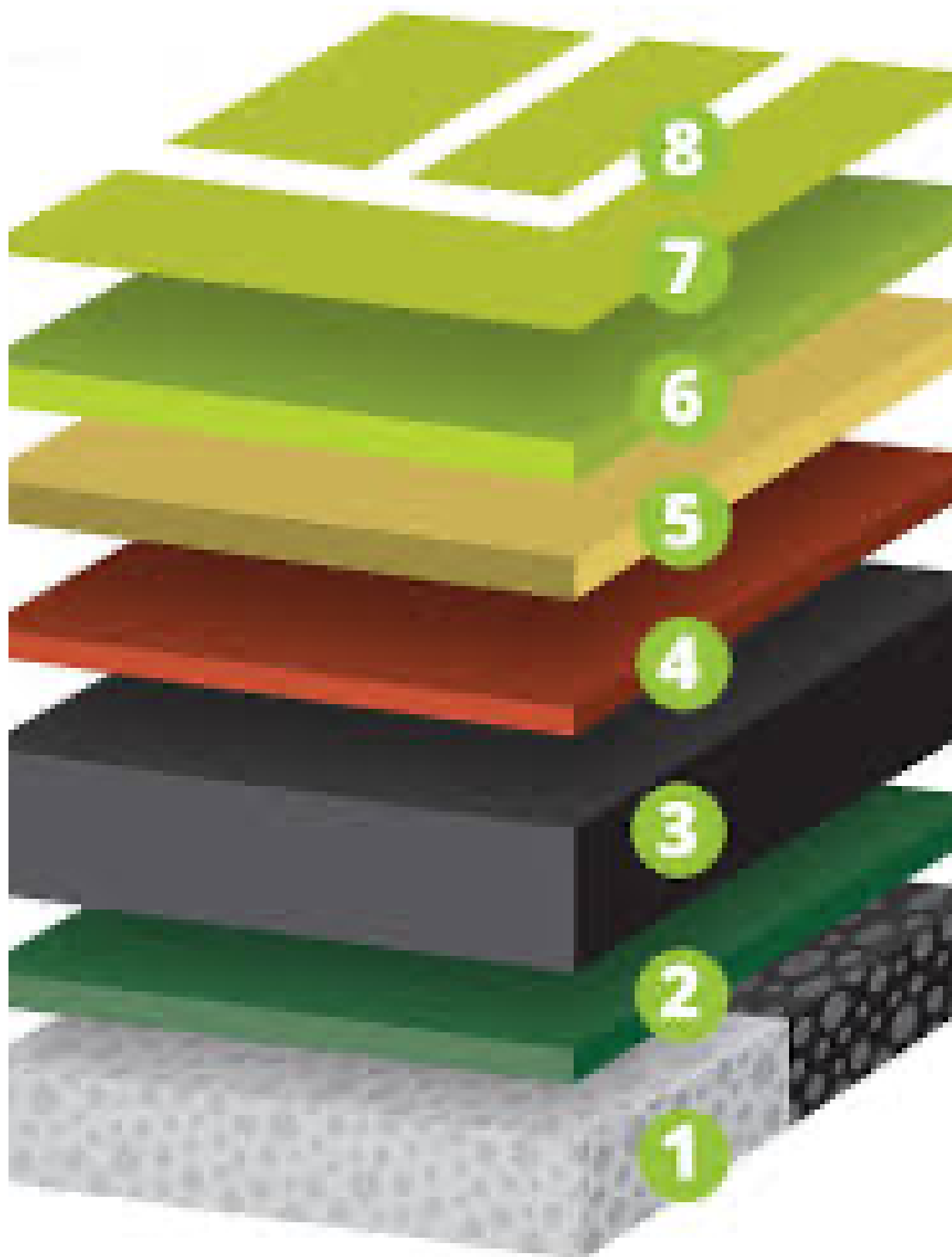
