FDR DOUBLES UP ON THE COURT

"It was a very physical game," Roosevelt coach Cliff Sauer said. "We went to the line 21 times and we probably should have gone 41 times."

That ended up being one of the keys to the game, actually, as the Presidents went 17-for-21 from the stripe.

Demelis ran into foul trouble with three in the first half but FDR had some tremendous help defense against Albany's standout player, who has a ride to Division I Siena awaiting her. Gianna Caprioli scored the first five points of the game and later buckled down to lead the defensive performance. Caroline Steigerwald and Kate Drickie both contributed strong minutes as well.

"Those three girls did a tremendous job," Sauer said.

The Roosevelt boys also won on Monday night, traveling to Wallkill for a 63-60 overtime victory. FDR's Jake London led all scorers with 23 points. Josiah Smith and Justin Patsey added 13 apiece for the Presidents.

Brian Cross led four Wallkill players in double figures with 15 points. Kyle Krebs – who sent the game into overtime with a three-pointer with 2.2 seconds left – and Justin Noelizaire each scored 13 points, and Mat Shea added 11.
