Our President's Message

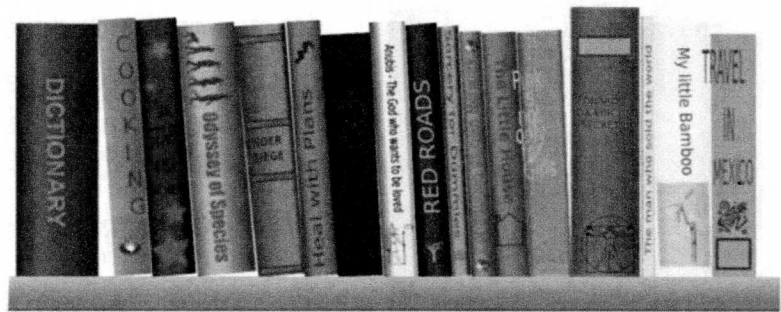
As the New Year approaches much too fast, it's time to reflect upon the past year. A time to celebrate with family and friends. Sad, some are no longer with us.

"Dick Francis, the bestselling master of mystery and suspense, takes you into the thrilling world of horse racing:

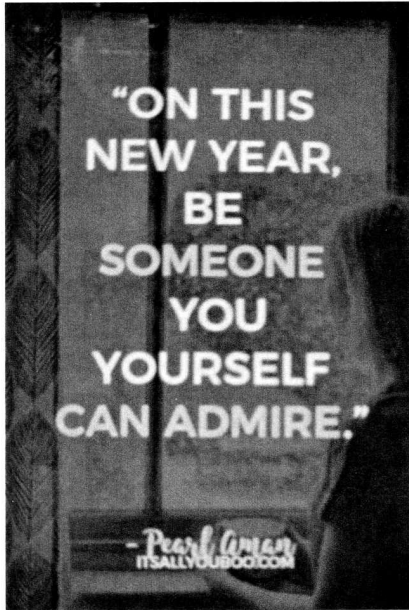
